What is the Army Career Skills Program (CSP):

CSP provides transitioning Soldiers with industry-recognized credentials and comprehensive job skills training to significantly enhance their employment prospects.

Who Is Eligible:

- Soldiers must be within 180 days of their separation/retirement date. Initiate your CSP packet EARLY to maximize your opportunities in the program.
- All Soldiers must complete the TAP Career Readiness Standards requirements.
- Must have Commander approval.

➡ Career Skills Program Participation Guidelines

- Must register for TAP
- Must attend Individualized Initial Counseling (IIC) and Pre-Separation Brief (PSB)
- Attend Career Skills Program Brief virtually
- Identify and enroll in a Career Skills Program (CSP), a DoW SkillBridge partnership, or an Individual Internship that aligns with your career goals.
- Complete the CSP checklist

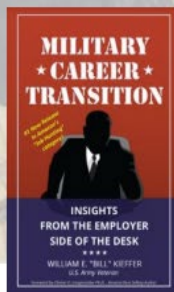

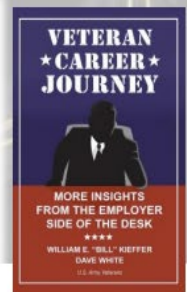

WARTAC

WHAT is WARTAC?

Warrior Training Advancement Course (WARTAC) is a DOD skill-bridge education and employment opportunity for Wounded Warriors and transitioning service members to complete a national-level Department of Affairs (VA), Veterans Benefits Administration (VBA), training program while still on active duty. Successful completion of this training program provides participants with an opportunity to learn the skill set of a VA Veteran Service Representative (VSR) or a Rating Veteran Service Representative (RVSR) at one of VBA's 56 Regional Offices around the country.



Upon successful completion of the WARTAC training program, participants would need to be available for potential employment no more than 60 days after the end of a WARTAC training session.

Availability to relocate based on VBA's employment needs is necessary for participation in WARTAC. Transitioning Servicemembers must secure command approval to participate in the WARTAC program and meet all DoD Career Skills Program requirements.

Attend a mandatory WARTAC briefing, 60 days from start of cohort. Briefings are virtual or in-person at the military installation hosting the cohort.

HOW DO YOU BECOME ELIGIBLE?

WARTAC is open to:

- Servicemembers who are transitioning and, upon successful completion of the WARTAC training program, would be available for potential employment no more than 60 days after the end of a WARTAC training session **and**
- National Guard or Reserve Component members may be eligible to participate in SkillBridge if you have 180 days of service or fewer remaining prior to your date of separation and you have at least 180 continuous days of active service.
