MEMORANDUM FOR DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Metal Detector Use Policy

1. References.

- a. AR 200-1, Environmental Protection & Enhancement, 13 December 2007
- b. Archaeological Resources Protection Act of 1979
- c. National Historic Preservation Act of 1966

2. Purpose. To inform personnel residing, visiting, or working on Fort Lee that the use of metal detectors anywhere within the bounds of Fort Lee is prohibited.

3. Policy. In order to protect known and unknown archaeological resources, the use of any form of metal detecting equipment is prohibited on all land under custody and control of the federal government unless an individual is in possession of a valid permit issued in accordance with the Archaeological Resources Protection Act of 1979 signed by the Garrison Commander or included as part of a government-issued cultural resource specific performance work statement associated with a contract award.

4. Applicability. This policy applies to all military, civilian and contractor personnel on Fort Lee, including installation residents, and non-residents.
