





Fill the Ruck: Carrying the Load for Each Other

Today, the Soldiers of the 189th Infantry Brigade stepped out together for a powerful cause: the "Fill the Ruck" ruck march at Joint Base Lewis-McChord.

This wasn't just about logging four miles with weight on our backs. It was about bearing a far more important weight together—the weight of the conversation around suicide prevention.

Along the route, our teams tackled challenges designed to strengthen our greatest asset: each other. At multiple stations, we practiced crucial communication, problem-solving, and teamwork. These moments reinforced that just like in these challenges, we can overcome any obstacle when we work together and communicate openly.

"Fill the Ruck" is a movement built on a simple but profound idea: that we all carry burdens, but we never have to carry them alone. By literally shouldering a ruck and working as a team, we symbolized our commitment to supporting our battle buddies, both on and off the battlefield. We ruck to remember those we've lost, to support those who are struggling, and to strengthen the bonds that make us resilient.

Every step was a step toward breaking the stigma. Every shared moment was a reminder that it's a sign of strength to ask for help. Our formation wasn't just about pace; it was a moving testament to our pledge to never leave a fallen comrade.

How to Host a Blood Drive: 6 Simple Steps

- 1. DATE:** Work with your unit's S3 and Command Team to determine a general time to host your blood drive, planning a blood drive with at least 30-days' notice is best but not necessary.
- 2. SCHEDULE:** Reach out to the Armed Services Blood Bank Center – PNW's Recruiter at to check availability and to select the best date for your unit to host. Blood drives are normally scheduled Monday-Friday from 0900-1400.
- 3. LOCATION:** Select a location for the blood drive. Your unit's COF or a large training room often work best. Requirements for the space: must be temperature controlled, good lighting, and available electrical outlets for blood drive equipment.
- 4. INCENTIVIZE:** Ensure your Command Team supports the blood drive and encourage authorization for an incentive for those who donate. Examples of incentives: Late Call, Early Release, 3-Day Pass, COA for donating 3 times, AAM for donating 5 times, hours towards MOVSM, etc.
- 5. PROMOTE:** Post promotional flyers (these will be provided to you) throughout your work area, the barracks, and encourage service members to share the blood drive information with their family members. Share the flyer via email, post to social media, any way that you communicate with your service members, ensure they have been informed and are motivated to donate at the blood drive.
- 6. PRESENCE:** On the day of the blood drive, be present at the blood drive, reach out to those that have not stopped by to donate, and encourage all to participate.
