 - ❑ **18 pts** within **24 consecutive months**





Infrastructure Investment in Traffic Calming Measures

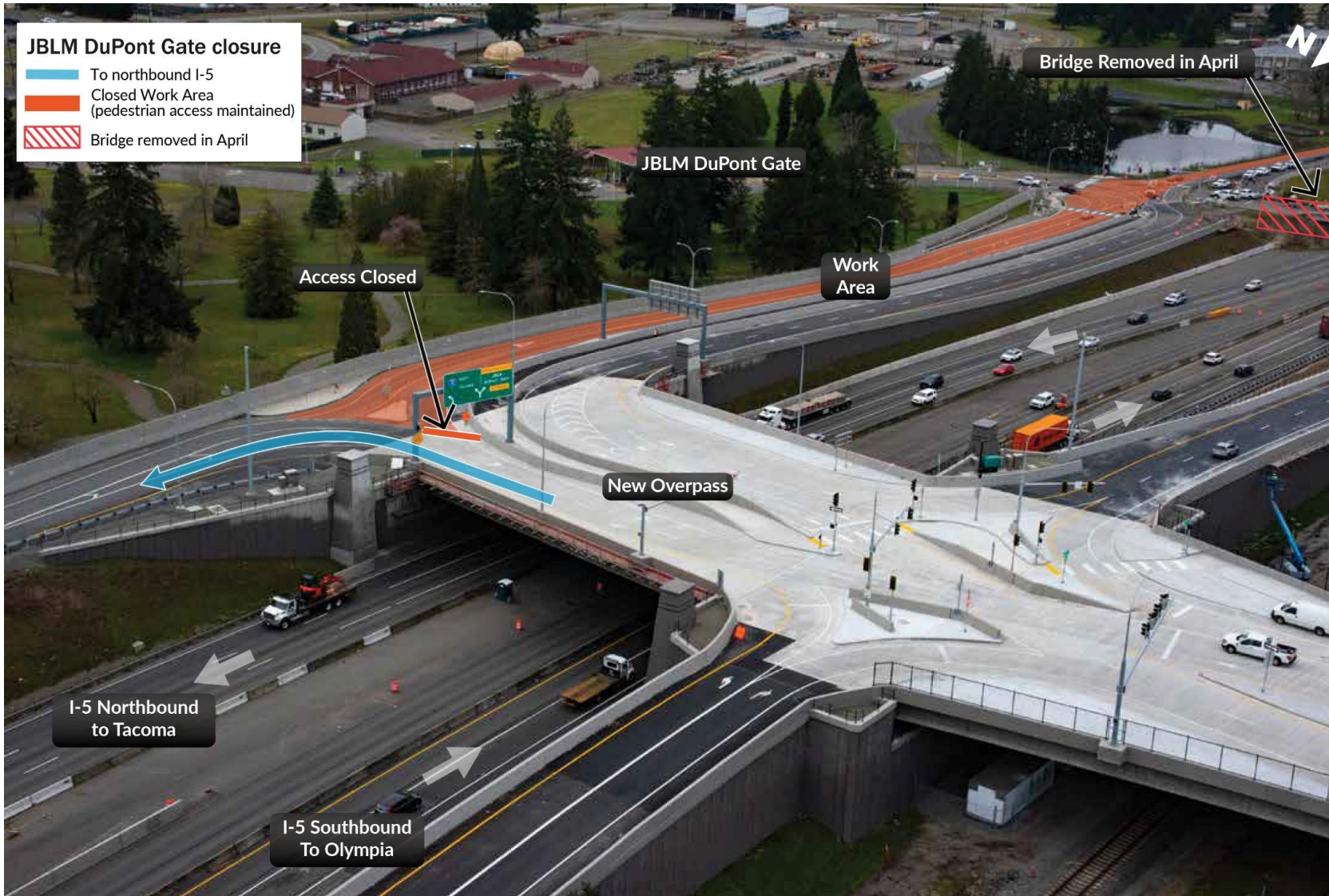
- **Phase 1 (FY26): Initial Implementation and Awareness**
 - ❑ Apply “**SCHOOL**” **rumble-strip** pavement markings in school crosswalks
 - ❑ Install targeted **temporary speed bumps** at high-risk locations
 - ❑ Install **permanent speed humps** at 7 Access Control Points and key roads
- **Phase 2 (FY27): Physical Traffic Calming Measures**
 - ❑ Install 10 **pedestrian-activated flashing systems** at schools and high-use crosswalks
- **Phase 3 (FY28 and Beyond): Long-Term Solutions**
 - ❑ Install **swing gates** at 8 ACPs
 - ❑ Integrate enhanced traffic-calming features during **right-of-way upgrades**

Pendleton Underpass and DuPont Gate Closures

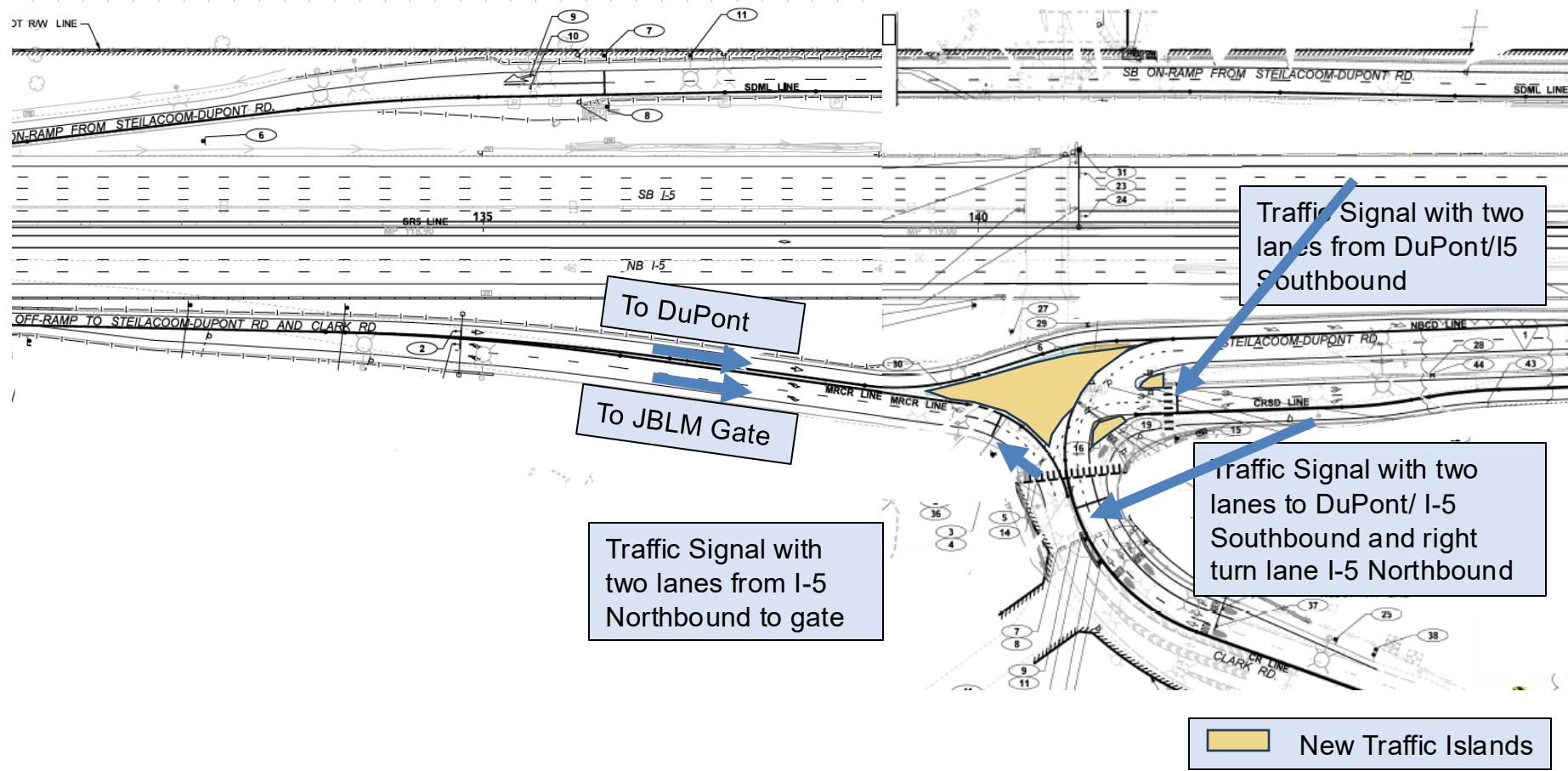
- Details of the closure:
 - State of Washington funded WSDOT to widen I-5 thru JBLM corridor
 - Pendleton Underpass: closed 4 May, reopen 22 May
 - Dupont Gate: closure 23 May, reopen Tuesday 9 Jun
- What work to be completed during closure
 - Pendleton Underpass: lower road, increase clearance height to 14'-9"
 - Dupont gate: complete pavement/traffic islands, final striping, traffic signal
- How it will help traffic
 - Provide added clearance for vehicles going to/from Lewis Main & North
 - Corridor congestion improvement along I-5 fronting JBLM
- Alternate route during closure
 - **RCF Gate**, Monday – Friday, *excluding weekends/federal holidays*:
 - Inbound traffic: open from 5 a.m. – 12 p.m.
 - Outbound traffic: open from 12 p.m. – 7 p.m.



Recreational Vehicles/ Boats

- Recreational vehicles are not permitted to be stored within your neighborhood.
- For temporary passes for your recreational vehicle please visit your District Office for the process.
 - Passes are for 72Hrs and are for loading and unloading purposes



Pools and Hot Tubs

- Small pools 18 inches deep and less do not need approval
 - Must be drained and put away daily
- Approval is requested through your District Office
- Pools are only to be in place from Memorial Day to Labor Day
- Pools must be removed and stored no later than September 10th
- Pools are only allowed in fenced backyards that have self-latching gates
- Pools cannot be taller than the fence
- Only ladders made for pools are allowed
- No temporary structures are allowed around the pool
- No modifications to the homes electrical system
- \$100 Refundable Deposit required



Air Conditioning Policy

Window and portable air conditioners are permitted in all homes.

Residents no longer need to submit a request form prior to self-installing an air conditioner unit. Please contact your district office for a copy of the policy and installation guidelines.

Things to remember when installing your own unit.

- **Unit Size:** 6,000 BTU maximum
- **Unit Weight:** 46 pounds maximum
- **Power Requirements:** 110 Volt, 5.6 Amp maximum. No 220 Volt units are permitted.
- Clear plexi-glass material or plywood material painted to match the color of the window frame must be used for all exposed areas of installation.
- Liberty Military Housing will not be responsible for added electrical loading imposed by your equipment. (i.e. added utility costs on your Minol utility billing).
- Liberty Military Housing will not be responsible for any damage to the window or structure, including but not limited to window warping, mounting hardware damage, condensation leakage, or residue from foams or tapes, charges may apply for these damages.

Overfilled Trash Can Fees

- Every time you overfill your trash can, LeMay charges **\$8.60**
- Utilize Liberty's monthly bulk trash drop off Free! **20 and 23 May**
- Additional 30 Gal. LeMay bags can be purchased from your district office to place outside your can for **\$5.71**
- Call LeMay direct to set up an account for an additional can or a curb side pick up.
- **Beginning May 1st 2026 these fees will be passed on to residents.**



ENTERING YOUR HOME



- **48 Hour Written Notice**- Liberty may periodically enter your home for preventive maintenance (annually) or an asset preservation inspection. This is not a scheduled appointment; it is a legal notice.
 - Posted
 - Emailed
- **Work Orders** - When you submit a work order, the form will request permission to enter your residence to complete work.
 - Pets must be secured while a technician is in your home performing work.
 - No person under 18 years old may be left alone when work is being performed.

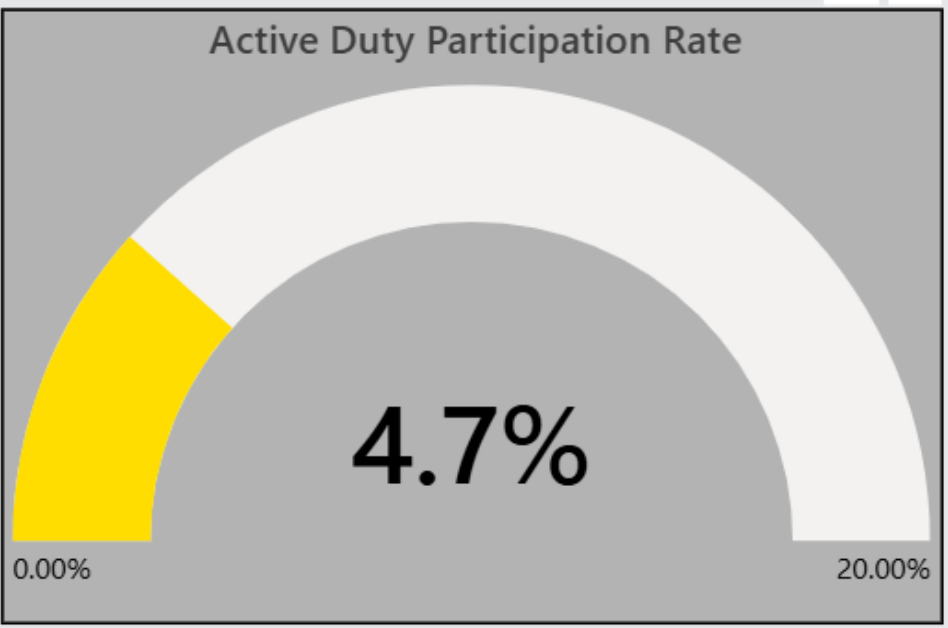



Fire Safety

JBLM Fire Prevention Program

- Commanders/Directors appoint Building Managers/Fire Marshals for all administrative and industrial facilities installation-wide IAW JBLM 420-30 and AR 420-5
- Building Managers/Fire Marshals receive formal training through the JBLM Fire Prevention Office
- Building Managers/Fire Marshals perform monthly fire and life safety self-inspections and provide fire extinguisher training to newly assigned and permanent-party personnel

Facility Incident Rate (FY 2025)

- JBLM Fire Department responded to 19 facility-related fire incidents
 - 10 buildings with 90% containment fire damage limited to the area of origin
 - 9 kitchen fires all contained to the stove top/oven area
- 19 incidents across 7,000 structures and a JBLM population of 295,251
 - 0.06 incidents per 1,000 – exceptionally low
- High containment rates are a strong indicator that the JBLM Fire Prevention Program is effective



Seasons, Regulations, and Fees

- All seasons, gear restrictions, and harvest rules in accordance with published WDFW booklets, <https://wdfw.wa.gov/publications>
- Hunters/anglers must have applicable state licenses/tags in addition to iSportsman permit
- Low Velocity hunting includes all archery, muzzleloader, shotgun
- iSportsman fees
 - Dependent on account type
 - Active Duty E1-4 (Annual)
 - Recreation \$5
 - Fishing \$10
 - Hunting \$20
 - WA Resident (Annual)
 - Recreation \$40
 - Fishing \$50
 - Hunting \$120
 - ORV Park \$75 (Annual, all users)
 - Solo Point boat launch \$10 (Daily, all users)



Safety Concerns

Swimming

Swimming is prohibited in the JBLM Training Areas (TAs), including all lakes, rivers, and at Solo Point.

Boating

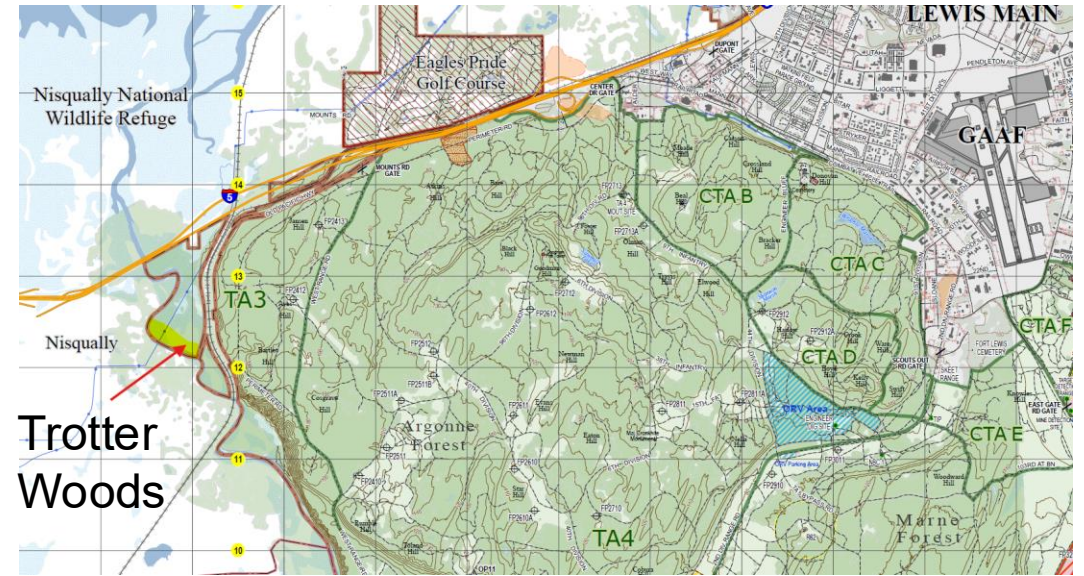
Non-motorized boating only in JBLM TAs. Beware swift currents and cold water at Solo Point and Nisqually River.

Wildlife

JBLM TAs home to bears, cougars, elk, wasps. Use caution, make noise in heavy brush, bring epi-pen, notify a friend of planned location.

Fire

Extreme fire danger in JBLM grasslands. Do not park on prairie, be careful with sparks and other ignition sources.



Salmon fishing opens July 1st
