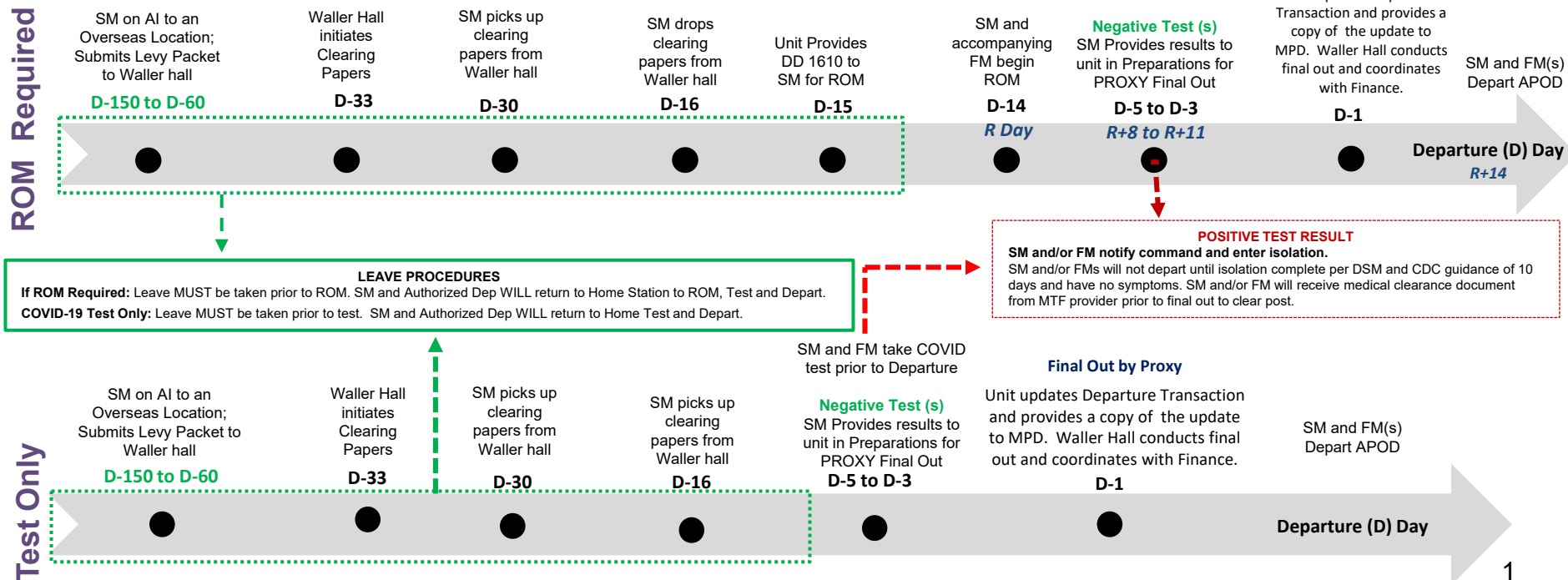
BLUF: COVID 19 PCS TEST REQUIREMENT: Regardless of ROM requirements ALL Soldiers, Family Members and DA Civilians PCSing OCONUS will take a COVID 19 test (with negative results) prior to departure to new location.

Stateside ROM: Most countries do not require a stateside ROM IAW FRAGO 11 Annex PP. Soldiers and Commander need to verify requirements in Annex PP, however Soldiers and their Command must verify using Annex PP.

*Frequently traveled Locations that **DO NOT** require stateside ROM: Republic of Korea, Japan, Germany, Italy, Belgium, Turkey, Thailand, and Philippines*

Stateside Testing Requirements: A COVID test **MUST BE COMPLETED** as close to the SM (and authorized dependents) departure date. The testing will occur at the losing duty station.

Leave Procedures: Commanders may authorize leave necessary for the most direct means of travel. Any personal leave beyond what is needed for direct travel **MUST** be taken **BEFORE** administrating the COVID Test. Leave in conjunction is not authorized per HQDA FRAGO 11.





Responsibilities if ROM is Required

as of 26 Aug 20



SM Responsibilities

- Return completed levy packet (electronically) to MPD, Waller Hall.
- Submit DA31 for pre-PCS leave to unit Commander (leave must be executed prior to beginning ROM).
- Initiate, then pick up clearing papers from Waller Hall.
- Clear, then submit completed clearance packet to Waller Hall (this includes HHG shipment, POV Shipment, Quarters clearance, etc.).
- Execute ROM & COVID Test. Provide Negative Test results to Unit Rep from the MHS Genesis Portal Page
- Confirm unit has executed proxy clearing for Final Out.
- Move directly to APOD and begin PCS Travel.

Losing Unit Commander Responsibilities

- If ROM lodging is required, initiate manual DA 1610 at unit.
- Establish procedures to track SMs through each step of the process identified under SM responsibilities.
- Assess time available for SM to complete - coordinate deferments with Corps G1/MPD as required.
- Ensure all departing personnel have a GTC with adequate limit/ensure departing SMs understand COVID specific entitlements.
- Provide single SMs barracks space to execute ROM. Coordinate with I Corps if unit cannot provide.

G1/MPD Responsibilities

- Provide unit Commanders with a list of personnel scheduled to PCS to overseas locations—update weekly
- Identify SMs who have not returned levy packet to MPD to unit Commanders—elevate SMs over 10 days delinquent to Corps DCG
- Coordinate and track deferments as requested by unit Commanders
- MPD/Waller Hall conducts final out and coordinates with Finance

COVID Testing Responsibilities

- Soldiers must be tested at their losing duty station
- Testing is available through Madigan through their drive through station
- Your orders are all you need to show as a requirement for testing
- Testing should be conducted as close to departure as possible.
