MEMORANDUM FOR DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: HAZMAT Endorsement requirement on Military License for transporting ammunition.

1. References:

- a. AMC REG 700-77, Para 6-4a
- b. JBLM REG 700-20, (Draft, Para 5-3b(2))

2. Intent. Provide clarification and guidance for HAZMAT endorsement on Military License for the purpose of transportation of ammunition across the Department of Defense.

3. Scope. This policy applies to any individual involved in transporting ammunition that is assigned to the U.S. Army and follows all AMC regulations, guidance, local policies and procedures. Service members assigned to other branches will follow their service specific guidance as directed by their applicable regulations and policies as required.

4. General. The Ammo-67 (HAZMAT Familiarization and Safety in Transportation) distance learning course is the requirement to receive the HAZMAT endorsement on an Army Military Driver's License (DA Form 5984-E). Effective 1 March 2021, the Ammo-67 distance learning course will be a pre-requisite to enroll in the Ammo Handler Certification Course (AHCC) on JBLM along with the Ammo-45 (Introduction to Ammunition) and Ammo-68 (Military Munitions Rule) distance learning courses.

5. This policy will be given widest dissemination and will be briefed at all future Ammunition Manager Meetings hosted by 593d ESC.
