Environmental Training Notes:

1. JBLM Lewis Regulation 200-1 (FL Reg. 200-1) implements the requirements of federal, state, regional, and local environmental laws and regulations. Reference to this regulation is a requirement for all users of JBLM and its sub-installations, especially for field training and motor pool operations.
2. Report spills to JBLM Lewis Fire Department or to Range Operations (253) 967-6371.
3. Digging or soils excavation requires a digging permit. Contact Public Works for the permit. Ranges and training areas must be scheduled through Range Support.
4. Maintain a 100 meter minimum distance from lakes, streams, and wetlands for the following approved activities:
 - a. Refueling activities
 - b. Assembly areas
 - c. Field latrines and soakage pits
 - d. Field showers and kitchen sumps
 - e. Hazardous material storage areas
5. Maintain a 50 meter minimum distance from lakes, streams, and wetlands during off-road movement or the siting of vehicle positions (i.e. hull downs, defilade).
6. All range/training complex use requires check-in and check-out at Range Support, Building 4074.
