Garrison "DHR" EFMP Family Support - Elective Services

The Joint Base Lewis-McChord (JBLM), DHR EFMP Family Support is an elective program offering Systems Navigator support to enrolled EFMP active Army and Air Force Service Members assigned to the installation.

The primary role of a Systems Navigator is to connect families with resources, referrals and processes - helping them become their own best advocates.

Services are tailored to each individual family's needs and include:

- · Information and referral for military support providers and community services
- Conduct a Family Needs Assessment to identify and prioritize family goals
- Develop a Family Service Plan to reach identified goals
- Non-clinical case management
- Special Education Support with Individualized Education Program (IEP)
- Respite Care Options
- Warm handoffs to the EFMP Family Support Services at your next duty station

Madigan EFMP Enrollment - Mandatory Services

Enrollment in the EFMP is mandatory for active duty military members. When a family member is identified with special medical and/or educational needs, the special needs are documented through enrollment in the EFMP. Medical services work with families to coordinate identification and enrollment in EFMP.
