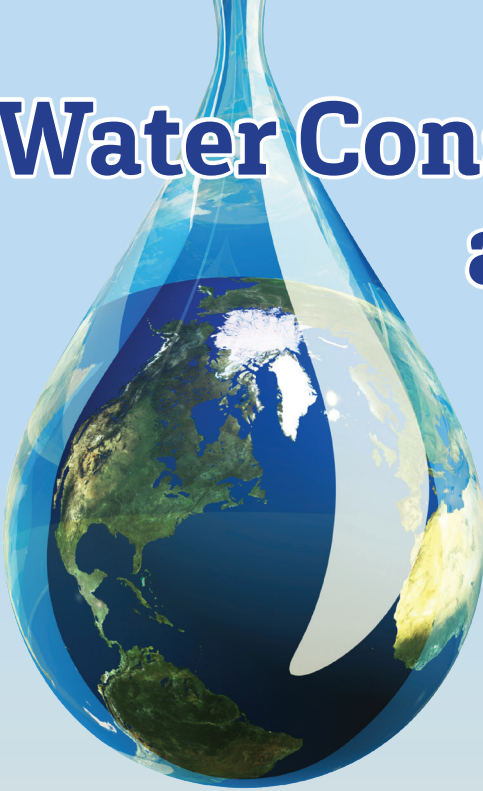


# Water Conservation at JBLM



As Joint Base Lewis-McChord and surrounding communities continue to grow, the demand for water increases, along with the need for conservation. To ensure a sustainable supply exists for present and future training needs at JBLM, here's a quick guide.

**Residential:** 10 minutes a day per irrigation location/zone or sprinkler head

**Level 1:** Houses with even numbers water on even days; houses with odd numbers water on odd days.

**Level 2:** Even house numbers water Wednesdays and Saturdays; odd house numbers water Thursdays and Sundays.

**Level 3:** Outside water use is not allowed.

**General landscape and turf-nonpride areas:** 10 minutes a day per irrigation location/zone or sprinkler head

**Level 1:** Water every third day (optimum)

**Level 2:** Water every fourth day (deficit)

**Level 3:** Water every seventh day (survival)

**Pride areas:** Sports fields, golf courses and parade fields have specific guidance based on the turf type, irrigation system and intensity of use.

*Effective irrigation is to apply the correct amount of water at the correct time to optimize uptake by the root system. Conservation measures were developed using regional local weather station evapotranspiration data that provides a scientific basis for healthy growth.*
