Pre-Requisites:

- 32 Hour CPOF Certificate within 60 days of course
- Active, Reserve or National Guard
 - Officers: 2LT – LTC
 - Warrant Officers: Must complete WOBC
 - Enlisted: SGT – SGM
- Normal Color Vision
- US Citizen
- Possess a Secret Clearance

MCSIC Course Prerequisites

Before course attendance or as refresher training, soldiers should attend the 32 hour CPOF/CPCE course within the last 60 days at the ITB Bldg. 3087 and bring your course completion certificate to class.

1. Navigate to <https://cacmdc.army.mil/cact/JBLM/SitePages/MTC.aspx> (requires CAC or AKO login)
1. Click the “Mission Command Information Systems” (MCIS) (CPOF, JCR, AFATDS)
3. Select CPOF
4. Select “Click Here to Request Training”
5. Find appropriate Date for CPOF Training.
