Weapons Registration Fact Sheet

Why register?

Per AR 190-11, any person who resides on JBLM is required to register their weapon with the DES. Additionally, any weapon brought onto any portion of JBLM is also required to be registered. Failure to do so may result in your apprehension for unlawful possession of a firearm and confiscation of the weapon. Registered weapons can be used for permitted hunting, at a number of MWR ranges, and for installation sanctioned competitions. Having a weapon registered also allows the Police to more easily identify any found weapons or a weapon reported as stolen.

How to register

You can download a Weapon Registration Form by going to:

https://home.army.mil/lewis-mcchord/application/files/1114/8892/8409/weapon_registration_1.pdf. You can take a completed form to Waller Hall (0730-1530, M-F) or to either Visitor Control Center. Do not bring the weapon with you when registering.

Where does my information go?

When you register your weapon, it is locally entered into the Army law enforcement reporting system. This information is not shared with other Police agencies.

How do I remove my information?

You may go to Waller Hall and request to de-register your weapon(s) at any time.

Please remember that concealed carry is NOT authorized on JBLM.

Registered Weapons must be transported unloaded, in a locked case, and separate from the passenger compartment.
