This permit may be revoked at anytime by American Water Military Services. Wastewater introduced to the collection system may only occur at approved discharge locations. At no time may wastewater containing oil, hazardous substances, or chemicals materials not approved under this permit or in non-compliance with the permit or departmental discharge permit be introduced to the collection system.

American Water Military Services reserves the right to enforce prohibitive discharge standards as set forth in 40 CFR 403.5(a) and (b) categorical pretreatment standards promulgated pursuant to Section 307(b) and (c) of the Act (where applicable), and local limitations and Best Management Practices (BMPs) in accordance with 40 CFR 403.5(c), whichever are more stringent and are applicable to non-domestic users discharging wastewater into the collection system. This may include obtaining remedies from any industrial user noncompliance with applicable pretreatment standards and requirements, including but not limited to, reporting user's non-compliance status to the Environmental Protection Agency, prohibition from future discharge permit issuance, and fines and penalties.
