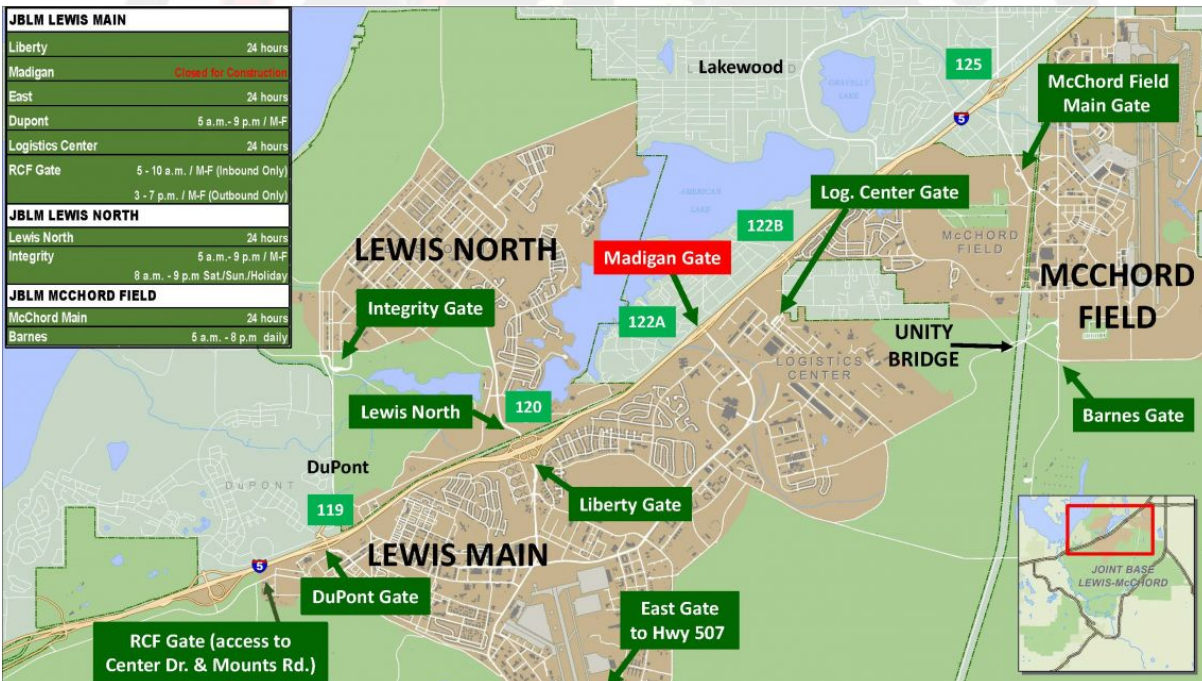




ACCESS CONTROL AND GATE HOURS

JBLM is a controlled-access installation. Vehicles with an adult, DoD ID cardholder, may enter through any gate. Vehicles without an adult, DOD ID cardholder present, must report to the Visitor Control Center adjacent to the Lewis Main Liberty Gate (I-5 exit 120) to receive a Temporary Pass.

Temporary Pass. You must have a valid driver's license, vehicle registration, proof of insurance, and an adult, authorized DOD sponsor, willing to sponsor your base access. Sponsors must be available by phone to complete the pass issuance process. Below are the primary gates. To ensure your pay account is updated accurately and in a timely manner, ensure you have the following items available when you attend your day 2 finance brief:

- Hard copy of your PCS orders, all pages, and any amendments
- I PPS-A Absence form (leave form) for HRAP or PTDY and your
- I PPS-A Absence form (leave form), that shows when you signed in at the IRC.

Ensure you have digital copies of the same documents available in your email, as well as any receipts from your PCS. When we are completing your Smart Voucher, you will need the digital copies to upload into the system.

You will have access to a computer in IRC computer lab.

Failure to have the required documents, may cause delays with your finance in-processing, causing either an overpayment or underpayment of entitlements.

TO QUALIFY FOR RPP

- **Step 1** – Find a place. Please note, rent may not exceed your BAH.
- **Step 2** – Secure an Intent to Rent from the property. You may only have 1 at a time. Pay \$100 per BR for holding fee to hold your unit.
- **Step 3** – Submit the following documents to your property manager and the property manager will schedule an appointment for you:
 - a. Intent to Rent from Selected Property
 - b. RPP Application
 - c. Assignment orders to JBLM if you are not signed in yet
 - d. ERB/ORB/SURF as applicable
 - e. Most recent end-of-month LES*
 - f. Intent to vacate if you reside in on-base housing
 - g. Other support documents as requested
 - *Be prepared to provide a signed DA 5960 if your BAH is not showing on your LES. You may obtain a signed copy of your DA5960 from your Unit.
 - If you are flagged or pending medical separation, please provide a memorandum from your Commander/Doctor stating you will not be released from the military in the next 6 months.
 - If you have a Service Animal, please provide proper documentation as well.

IRC HOUSING (BARRACKS) INFORMATION

Please review the items below to ensure you have a safe and pleasant stay at the IRC.

AMENITIES

- ✓ **All essentials are provided at the reception desk.** For example, toilet paper, trash bags, or additional linen are available at the front desk.
- ✓ **Recreation materials are provided at the reception desk.** Soldiers may request recreation materials such as billiards equipment, gaming consoles, board games, and books.
- ✓ **Laundry Rooms are available in A and D wings.** Laundry rooms are in A wing on all floors (females only) and in D wing on 2nd and 3rd floors (males only).
- ✓ **Report housing issues with ease.** The flyer on the back of your barracks door contains a QR code that allows you to report any housing issues directly to the IRC facility manager.

PROHIBITIONS

- ✓ **The main door is the only authorized entry and exit door.** Soldiers are not authorized to use other exterior doors unless directed by Cadre. Side doors are for emergencies.
- ✓ **Barracks Soldiers are prohibited from engaging in sexual intercourse or drinking during in-processing.** Smoking, vaping, or dipping is not permitted within the facility. The only authorized smoking, vaping, or dipping area is the designated gazebo outside the facility.
- ✓ **Visitors are only authorized in the reception, sponsorship, or dining areas.** Visitors are anyone that is not currently in-processing the reception center. They are not authorized in any other locations in the facility.
- ✓ **Female Soldiers are not authorized in the male wings and vice-versa.** Female Soldiers reside in A wing and Male Soldiers reside in the B, C, and D wings.
- ✓ **The IRC will contact the MPs for vehicles parked illegally.** Diagonal lines and cones in the parking lot indicate unavailable parking spaces. Parking in these spaces obstruct traffic and hinder reception operations.

ACCOUNTABILITY

- ✓ **Barracks Soldiers must sign in for breakfast at 0730.** You are not required to eat breakfast at the IRC, but you must sign in for accountability after PRT.
- ✓ **Barracks Soldiers must sign the accountability roster on Non-Duty Days.** This roster differs from the in-processing roster or sign-in and out roster. Barracks Soldiers must sign the accountability roster between 0200 and 1030 at the Reception Desk.
- ✓ **The Travel Radius is 15 miles while at the IRC.** After duty hours you may travel off JBLM. You may not travel further than 15 miles in any direction from the IRC. For example, you may travel to the Tacoma Mall or the Olympia Mall.
- ✓ **Sponsors must physically meet their Soldier at the IRC.** By day 3 of in-processing, Soldiers must physically meet with their sponsor at the sponsorship desk or they will not ship to their unit on day 4.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- **Can I take leave, pass, or PTDY during in-processing?** No. Everyone is required to fully complete in-processing once they sign in at the IRC. The IRC is not legally permitted to approve absences requests for newly arrived Soldiers.
- **Can I keep my POW at the IRC during in-processing?** No. The IRC does not store POWs for in-processing personnel. Gaining unit armorers will secure POWs prior to the Soldier starting Day 1.
- **Can I conduct PRT with my unit while in-processing?** No. All in-processing Soldiers, regardless of rank, are required by command to conduct PRT at the IRC.
- **Can I stay in the barracks provided by my unit while in-processing?** No. All barracks Soldiers are required to reside at the IRC.
- **Can I travel outside the 15-mile radius to visit my family while in-processing?** No. All barracks Soldiers must remain within the 15-mile radius during in-processing. This includes weekends and DONSAAs.
- **As a senior, can I skip some in-processing steps to ship to my unit faster?** No. All Soldiers, regardless of rank, are required by Corps command to in-process the entire model.
- **Do I need approved leave to submit my travel voucher?** Yes. JBLM finance rejects travel vouchers missing an IPPS-A approved absence. This does not apply to accessions.
- **Does my recruiter need to sign my HRAP (Home-town Recruiting Assistance Program)?** Yes. Your recruiter must annotate on your leave form in the comments section your HRAP completion within the approved leave time.
- **Am I allowed to search for a house while I am in-processing?** Yes. However, your in-processing requirements takes precedence over personal activities.
- **Can my sponsor sign me out to visit my unit while I am in-processing?** Yes, if your PSG is aware, grants you permission, and you've completed all requirements for the day. Additionally, Leader and Sponsorship Luncheon opportunities are built into the model.

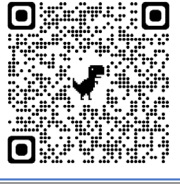
