3rd Party Congress Mandated Housing Inspection Update



- Inspections take place from 21 April 23 May
- 4,299 Inspections have been completed 83% Complete
- 208 Homes had Life/Health/Safety Issues Identified LMH Responded
- 95% of the Life/Health/Safety Issues should have been called in by the Resident
 - Toilets leaking, outlet covers cracked/missing, outlets inoperable, dishwasher leaking, leaking hose bibs, heat not working, mildew/mold on the bathroom walls, window cracked, smoke alarm not working
- Residents can download the LMH maintenance app, its free and very convenient or they can call the liberty at your service 888-578-4141 which is 24/7 answered service.

All residents are required to register their pet with Liberty Military Housing when adding a pet to the household. Any unregistered pets is a lease violation.

How to register your

pet:



- Submit photos
- Vaccination records
- Medical documentations



It is important that all pets be registered so that their owners can be contacted if necessary for the safety of our residents.



Air Conditioning Policy

Window and portable air conditioners are permitted in all homes. Residents no longer need to submit a request form prior to self-installing an air conditioner unit. Please contact your district office for a copy of the policy and installation guidelines.

Things to remember when installing your own unit.

- Unit Size: 6,000 BTU maximum
- Unit Weight: 46 pounds maximum
- Power Requirements: 110 Volt, 5.6 Amp maximum. No 220 Volt units are permitted.
- Clear plexi-glass material or plywood material painted to match the color of the window frame must be used for all exposed areas of installation.
- Liberty Military Housing will not be responsible for added electrical loading imposed by your equipment. (i.e. added utility costs on your Minol utility billing).
- Liberty Military Housing will not be responsible for any damage to the window or structure, including but not limited to window warping, mounting hardware damage, condensation leakage, or residue from foams or tapes, charges may apply for these damages.

PCSING TIPS

How to prepare for moving out for PCS

- Notify your designated district office and submit your notice to vacate your home once you receive your new orders.
 - A move-out inspection will be scheduled with you to ensure the home is in quality condition and there are no significant damages upon move-out.
- Utilize your move-out checklist to ensure you are prepared to turn the home back over to Liberty Military Housing and avoid any extra move-out costs.
- Take advantage of our twice a month FREE bulk drop-off to dispose of any unwanted items.

Rideshare Program



JBLM has been selected to participate in a FORSCOM Rideshare Pilot Program. Directorate of Emergency Service (DES) and the Public Affairs Office (PAO) are currently supporting this program to assess more effective ways to facilitate rideshare and food delivery access to the installation.

In the Interim DES is establishing a way that CAC holders can be rideshare drivers

- Once a current ID cardholder is confirmed by his/her company (e.g., Uber, Lyft) as being employed by them they will be credentialed for a year. *Note current ID cardholders are prohibited by regulation to use their base access privileges for commercial use.*
- The rideshare companies will geofence the base so that these ID cardholders will get the fares originating on JBLM

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• DES will sponsor the rideshare drivers
