Congress Mandated 100% Housing Inspections



- JBLM inspections are scheduled **21 Apr 25 23 May 25**
- Inspections are <u>mandatory</u> & will last approximately one hour
- The 3rd Party, RER/JLL team implemented a web-based selfscheduling application available to the residents
- This application will close on 14 April 2025
- After this date, your inspection will be scheduled for you, and a date/time will be provided by the 3rd party contractor
- All inspections will be accompanied by a military escort

<u>Use the QR code to schedule your appointment.</u> If you encounter issues or did not receive an email and need assistance, contact RER/JLL at <u>army@housinginspections.info</u>. Their team is staffed full-time.





Residents only have <u>5</u> more days to lock in their inspection date!

The National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) FY2020 mandates all privatized housing will be inspected by a 3rd Party Contractor retained by DA to ensure housing is safe and habitable.





* Hybrid Solution Peak Season 2025 (Tender of Service(DPS) and GHC)

- > All Service Members will go through the SORT TOOL on the DPS landing page.
- Service Member is automatically routed to the correct system, MILMOVE or DPS, based on SORT TOOL. This eliminates possible uncertainty among Members and PPPOs based on changing program guidelines related to active/ inactive zips.
- Any Shipment involving Non-Temp Storage, boats, or specialized shipments (Wounded Warrior, BlueBark, Safety Moves) or OCONUS shipment request will continue to be routed through DPS
- > 15-Day Lead Times for HHG's and NTS
- Be Flexible with the <u>7-day spread dates</u>, and/or open to date options, if necessary, when arranging with GHC/DPS
- > PPM's, Full and Partial, will be processed in MILMOVE in Open Channels (Active Sites)





Seware of Rogue Movers

IMPORTANTBefore hiring a commercial mover, it is "highly" recommended you utilize a mover registered with the Federal Government at <u>https://www.fmcsa.dot.gov/protect-your-move</u> and validate the moving company's rating with the Better Business Bureau <u>https://www.bbb.org</u>

Household goods brokers or movers must provide you with basic information before you move. You should expect to receive the following information:

- A written estimate (Never sign a blank or incomplete estimate)
- The "Ready to Move" Brochure (https://www.fmcsa.dot.gov/protect-your-move/consumerrights -Highly Recommend you read)
- Information about the mover's arbitration program
- Written notice about access to the mover's tariff
- The process for handling claims
- Rights and Responsibilities When You Move Handbook (https://www.fmcsa.dot.gov/protectyour-move/consumer-rights - Highly Recommend you thoroughly read)

Avoid brokers and movers that are not registered with Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA), refuse to perform a physical survey of your household goods, and require cash only transactions. You can determine if your broker or mover is registered with FMCSA by going to the above website or calling FMCSA at (202)366-9805 for licensing and (866)637-0635 for insurance information.





GHC Updates

- MilMove is the customer facing application to request moves.
- Effective 4 March: HAS deactivated 11,000 zip codes in the Sort Tool through Peak Season.
- **13 March:** USTRANSCOM updated Peak Season 2025 zip phase-in listing. Listings automatically loaded in Sort Tool.
- 27 March: USTRANSCOM APPLE Advisory #25-0076
 - MilMove (GHC):
 - a. Domestic moves on GHC supported locations/channels with requested pick-up date >28 days from the time of submission.
 - b. Domestic moves on GHC supported locations/channels with requested pick-up date > 28 days from the time of submission and a full or partial PPM.
 - o <u>DPS Move (Legacy):</u>
 - a. Domestic moves on a non-GHC supported location/channel.
 - b. Domestic moves on a GHC supported location/channel without a PPM and with a requested pick-up date of <28 days.



HomeSafe Connect

Only a fraction of HHG moves have been processed under the GHC thus far; the legacy system remains active and continues to handle the majority of HHGs move globally (Total FY'25 42K (DPS: 40K (95%), GHC 2K (5%)







Are you moving from JBLM this Summer?

Bottom Line: The DoD is transitioning HHG movement to a new contractor (Home Safe Alliance) who is struggling to meet performance requirements. Soldiers moving under this new contract have increased risk of delayed HHG movement.

Soldiers Need to Know:

- Initiate HHG Counseling's NLT 60 days before desired Pick 1. 1. up Day on Move.Mil
- HHG Counselors notify Service Members if their move is 2. under the new contract.
- 3. Back brief leadership on HHG counseling and key dates
- DON'T initiate/terminate current living status without 4. moving company confirmed pack/pick dates.
- Be responsive to phone calls/emails from PPPO / JPPSO 5. / TSP / local agent and **proactively** engage these entities.
- Special Move Conditions: Service Members should go to 6. 3. the HHG Office 28 Days prior to their move if:
 - SM's move is initially booked under GHC а.
 - SM did not receive moving company confirmation of b. pack pick dates

Example PCS Timeline:



Leadership Support:

- Ensure Soldiers complete orders elections & leave form > 90 days prior to report date and HHG counseling >60 days prior to requested HHG Pick up Date.
- 2. ID Soldiers moving under GHC and confirm move status at 28 days from pick up date.
 - If Soldier does not have mover confirmed pack/pick dates, send them immediately to PPPO to build a special move.
 - If pack/pick dates are confirmed, continue to monitor for execution failure.
 - If a move is delayed, adjust the SM's report date and leave.
- HIGHLY RECOMMEND Service Members allow JBLM -4. Quality Assurance Evaluators to inspect/evaluate moving company pack/pick of HHGs to ensure quality service.
