## MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: 525th Expeditionary Military Intelligence Brigade (E-MIB) Welcome Letter.

- 1. **Purpose**. To welcome new members to the 525<sup>th</sup> E-MIB, Lightning Brigade.
- 2. **General.** Welcome to the Lightning Brigade! The premiere E-MIB in the United States Army. You have joined an organization with a rich and storied history that has contributed to multiple campaigns since its inception in 1948. You are joining a team with a winning mindset, comprised of dedicated Soldiers who are the masters of their craft, and are always ready to answer the call to rapidly deploy anywhere in the world.
- 3. **Mission.** The 525th E-MIB trains and rapidly deploys scalable, tailorable intelligence capabilities ISO XVIII Airborne Corps or worldwide contingency requirements. On order, deploy forward and provide mission command to assigned and/or attached MI forces supporting the deployed Corps/CJTF.
- 4. **Vision.** The 525th E-MIB is the premier intelligence brigade in the Army and is the first option in the Army for intelligence support. A unit that is cohesive, highly trained, disciplined, and physically fit, is value-added to our supported commanders, and wins at every opportunity.
- 5. **Organization**. The 525<sup>th</sup> E-MIB is one of only three Active-Duty E-MIBs in the U.S. Army and is assigned to the XVIII Airborne Corps at Fort Liberty, NC. The 525<sup>th</sup> E-MIB has assigned units stationed at Fort Liberty, NC, Fort Stewart, GA, and Fort Campbell, KY. At Fort Liberty, we have Headquarters and Headquarters Company/525<sup>th</sup> E-MIB, the 319<sup>th</sup> Intelligence and Electronic Warfare (IEW) Battalion (direct support to the 82<sup>nd</sup> Airborne DIV HQs), and the 519<sup>th</sup> IEW BN (direct support to the XVIII Airborne Corps HQs). At Fort Stewart, GA, we have the 103<sup>rd</sup> IEW Battalion (direct support to the 3<sup>rd</sup> Infantry DIV HQs) and the 302<sup>nd</sup> IEW Battalion at Fort Campbell, KY (direct support to the 101<sup>st</sup> Airborne DIV (Air Assault) HQs)).
- 6. Why We Exist. An E-MIB serves as the primary collection asset assigned or attached to the Corps and is designed to conduct intelligence operations to support operations. An E-MIB provides the following capabilities to a supported commander:
  - 1. Counterintelligence (CI) collection and operations
  - 2. Human intelligence (HUMINT) collection

- 3. Analysis and Processing, Exploitation, and Dissemination (PED)
- 4. Open-source intelligence (OSINT)
- 5. Geospatial intelligence (GEOINT) collection

- 8. Electronic Warfare (EW)
- 7. **Soldier and Family Readiness (SFRG).** The 525<sup>th</sup> E-MIB has a well-established SFRG Program, at all locations, which strives to support and enhance the readiness of the unit. The SFRG brings together family members, volunteers, Soldiers, and civilian employees to provide a forum of mutual support and assistance and a network of communication among the members, the chain of command, and community resources.
