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U.S. ARMY MATERIEL COMMAND DIGITAL GARRISON MOBILE APP



BACKGROUND

The U.S. Army has partnered with the Army & Air Force Exchange Service (AAFES) to create the Digital Garrison mobile app. Digital Garrison integrates information from AAFES and two Installation Management Command (IMCOM)-operated website networks: <https://home.army.mil> and <https://www.armymwr.com/>.

Digital Garrison is a one-stop information source for Army communities. The app puts real-time information into Soldiers', families', veterans' and civilians' hands and keeps military communities connected, a key part of readiness and resiliency.

Digital Garrison securely delivers information and facilitates access to a full range of installation Quality-of-Life services using information-age technology. Each instance of Digital Garrison is customizable to provide information specific to one of 62 Army garrisons selected by a user. More garrisons will be incorporated as they achieve technical requirements. Digital Garrison is the Army's enterprise app for its installations and will replace locally managed applications.

KEY FACTS

- Members of the Army family can download the Digital Garrison app to their personal mobile device now for free from both app stores.
- Digital Garrison features information specific to each user's community such as an installation directory, gate locations, fitness and recreation options, events and more.
- The Digital Garrison's dashboard includes a user profile, weather details and information on local Exchange shopping and restaurants.
- The app has access to ShopMyExchange.com, with in-app shopping and a mobile wallet with sales promotions and a secure method for storing payment options.
- Digital Garrison integrates information about installation services provided by IMCOM (includes Army MWR) and AAFES and will soon link to other capabilities and partners like RCI companies and the Defense Commissary Agency.
- The Digital Garrison was piloted by 450 Soldiers and families at 10 garrisons, both inside and outside of the U.S. The pilot validated the need for an app, with users requesting even more installation information than in the initial release.
- Digital Garrison is customizable by the user to provide information specific to one of 62 Army installations. More garrisons will be added as they achieve technical requirements.
- Digital Garrison will continually improve through responding to user feedback.
