SUBJECT: Proper Wear and Appearance of Army Uniforms and Civilian Attire at Fort Hunter Liggett and Parks Reserve Forces Training Area Dining Facilities

1. REFERENCES.

- a. AR 30-22 (The Army Food Service Program)
- b. AR 670-1 (Wear and Appearance of Army Uniforms and Insignia)

2. PURPOSE. This memorandum establishes standards and provides guidance for personnel authorized to subsist and procedures for all personnel (Military and Civilians) to abide with the proper wear and appearance of Army Uniforms and proper wear of civilian attire in dining Facilities (DFACs) located at Fort Hunter Liggett (FHL) and Parks Reserve Forces Training Area (PRFTA).

3 APPLICABILITY. These procedures are applicable to all Soldiers, Civilians, Family members, and contractors on Fort Hunter Liggett (FHL) and Parks Reserve Forces Training Area (PRFTA).

4. The following rules will apply:

- a. Military headgear will not be worn in the dining facilities unless an individual is "under arms." Only Law Enforcement Agencies and Military Police on duty may enter "under arms." IAW AR 670-1, para 1-10 K (2).

- b. Weapons are authorized in the dining facilities. Weapons must be properly cleared, magazine removed, and selector lever on SAFE prior to entering the facility. Weapons will be holstered (Pistols), M16/M4 Rifles will be slung across the back with the muzzle facing downwards.

- c. Authorized military and civilian clothing will not be mixed. Military uniforms will be worn in accordance with appropriate service regulations. Physical fitness Uniforms (PFU) are allowed but must be generally clean and not excessively wet with perspiration.

- d. Undergarments will not be worn as outer garments. Rollers, shower caps and pin curls are not allowed. Excessively revealing tank tops/sleeveless shirts will not be worn.

e. Clothing that is ripped, soiled, or presents an unhealthy or unclean appearance is not allowed in the dining facilities.

f. Shirts will be worn at all times. Shirts must cover the armpits and torso and will not display profanity, obscene sketches, pictures, or remarks.

g. Closed-toe shoes will be worn at all times.

h. Field gear, back packs/book bags, unit guidons, and other carried items will be stored near the sign-in area of the entry area.

i. The Food Program Manager (FPM), Quality Assurance Evaluator (QAE) or Contracting Officer's Representative (COR) may refuse service to personnel dressed in an extremely offensive manner or who are excessively unclean.
