Lieutenant Colonel Kate Brummer was born in Kingman, KS. She graduated from Kansas State University with a Bachelor of Science in Biology in 2005. In 2008, LTC Brummer completed a second Bachelor of Science in Cytotechnology at the University of Arkansas Medical Sciences. She was commissioned through the Officer Candidate School as a Second Lieutenant in 2009.

LTC Brummer's first assignment was as the Company Executive Officer in the 258th Nodal Support Company in Fort Sill, OK. She then joined the 2-18th Field Artillery Regiment as the Battalion S6. In 2014, LTC Brummer completed a Master's Degree in Human Relations from the University of Oklahoma while assigned to the 1st Engineer Battalion as the Battalion S6 at Fort Riley, KS. She then served as the Chief Information Management Officer and Senior Information Assurance Officer in the 1st Infantry Division G6.

In 2018, LTC Brummer was assigned as the Information System Officer in the 451st Sustainment Command (Expeditionary) G6, Wichita, KS. In 2020, she moved to Newport, RI, where she served as the 2nd Brigade, 78th Training Division Brigade S6, and Brigade Deputy Commander. LTC Brummer served as the ACoS, G6 in the 310th ESC, Indianapolis, IN, from 2022 to 2025. LTC Brummer is currently assigned as the Garrison Deputy Commander at Fort Hunter Liggett.
