**SUBJECT: USAG FHL Policy #9-4, Non-Military Use of Fort Hunter Liggett
Recreational Facilities**

1. **REFERENCE.** AR 215- 1, Nonappropriated Fund Instrumentalities and Morale, Welfare and Recreation Activities.
2. **PURPOSE.** To establish rules and guidance on Non-Military Use of Fort Hunter Liggett (FHL) FMWR recreational facilities.
3. **APPLICABILITY.** This policy applies to all Non-Department of Defense Identification Card Holders.
4. **POLICY.**

a. Local non-military civilian personnel that do not possess a common access card or reside on the installation may utilize the following facilities, as a sponsored guest, on Fort Hunter Liggett. Access is not authorized that is not specifically listed below.

- (1) Heritage Center
- (2) Historic Hacienda Lodging
- (3) Outdoor Recreation Center
- (4) ATM (within the Outdoor Recreation Center)
- (5) Car Wash
- (6) Cybrary
- (7) Liggett Lanes Bowling Center

b. Military personnel have priority to the above facilities.

c. All non-military personnel requesting access to facilities noted above will be processed at the Visitor's Center and vetted in accordance with Army Directive 2014-05, prior to entering the cantonment area.

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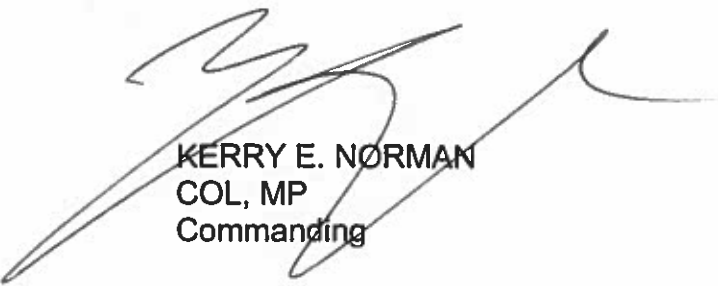
d. All sponsored guests must be accompanied by their sponsor for the duration of their visit to all facilities that require sponsorship. All sponsors must possess a valid common access card.

e. Access to named facilities does not grant permission to freely roam the Garrison, malingering on Post for extended periods of time, or to access other facilities. Access is granted for a specific purpose and one-time use.

5. FMWR BUSINESS ACCESS CARD. Purchase of this card will enable the user to access the following facilities without a sponsor.

- (a) Heritage Center
- (b) Historic Hacienda Lodging
- (c) ATM (within the Recreation Center)
- (d) Car Wash
- (e) Outdoor Recreation Center
- (f) Cybrary
- (g) Bowling Center
