Fort George G. Meade to Launch Service Line Inventory in Alignment with The EPA's Mandate




Fort George G. Meade Directorate of Public Works (DPW) will be conducting a comprehensive service line inventory to identify and address any lead pipes within its potable water system in accordance with Environment Protection Agency (EPA) mandates. As of the most recent report by American Water, Fort Meade meets or exceeds all EPA and MD Dept. of the Environment (MDE) standards.

Fort George G. Meade, Md. (July 23, 2024) — The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has unveiled an ambitious 10-year plan to remove all lead pipes from potable water distribution systems across the United States. This initiative aims to ensure safe drinking water for all communities, including those on Department of Defense (DoD) installations

Fort George G. Meade Launches Service Line Inventory

In alignment with the EPA's mandate, Fort George G. Meade will begin a comprehensive service line inventory to identify and address any lead pipes within its potable water system. This inventory marks a critical first step toward safeguarding the health and safety of the Fort Meade community.
