SUBJECT: Fort George G. Meade (FGGM) Policy Memorandum #11, Installation Food Service Program

1. References:

- a. AR 30-22, Army Food Program 17 July 2019
- b. DA PAM 30-22, Operating Procedures for the Army Food Program, 17 July 2019.

2. Purpose. The purpose is to provide guidance for use of the Freedom Inn Warrior Restaurant in Building 8502 (i.e., "Warrior Restaurant"). The Five Hats Warrior Restaurant in Building 9829 is utilized by NSA-affiliated meal cardholders and is not subject to the policies and procedures in this memorandum.

3. The following dress code is established to ensure all diners have a pleasant and comfortable experience while dining at the Freedom Inn Warrior Restaurant. This dress code will apply to all persons entering the facility.

- a. Shoes must be worn, no flip-flops.
- b. No excessively soiled, sweaty, or dirty clothes.
- c. Appropriate shirts or tops. No sleeveless shirts unless worn with a sleeved sweater or jacket. No shirts revealing the midriff.
- d. No clothing that reads anything profane.
- e. No soiled scrubs or lab coats.
- f. No swimwear, sheer, transparent, or otherwise inappropriate attire.

4. Units assigned to Fort George G. Meade are authorized one organization day per year. This authorization may be passed down to company-sized units. Subordinate units will not have a separate organization day activity if the parent unit conducts the organization day at its level in the same fiscal year IAW AR 30-22, Section 3-48I(1).

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a. Organization day subsistence will be provided to meal entitlement code (MEC) common access card (CAC) holders only in lieu of their meal that normally would be consumed at the Warrior Restaurant.

b. To request organization day subsistence for MEC CAC holders, submit a memorandum through the Logistics Readiness Center Director to the Garrison Commander. Requests should be submitted 30 days prior to the function and contain: date and time required, location, a by-name list of those service members authorized SIK, DoD ID number of service members, and the point of contact's name and telephone number. The Unit Commander must sign the request. Warrior Restaurant equipment (refrigerator, stoves, pots, and pans, freezers, etc.) may not be used to prepare or store food for any activity in support of organization day or social functions.

5. Holiday meals will be served on the actual holiday or on the actual day of the Army's birthday. I reserve the right to authorize an exception to the actual day of service when circumstances warrant.

6. All individuals with a valid CAC, military, or dependent ID are authorized to consume meals in the Warrior Restaurant located in Building 8502.

7. The use of Government subsistence, Warrior Restaurant and DFAC equipment, dining room space and DFAC staff to support social functions such as retirements, promotion, or award ceremonies, religious activities (retreats and seminars), coffee calls, change of command functions, parties, or other similar functions is prohibited. Support for such functions must be obtained from sources outside the Army Food Program.

8. Arrangements for social functions may be made with the installation club systems or other non-appropriated fund food and beverage facilities governed by AR 215-1, IAW AR 30-22, Section 3-48j. Social functions are defined as retirements, promotions, award ceremonies, coffee calls, change of commands and parties or other similar functions excluding spiritual fitness breakfasts IAW DA PAM 30-22, Para 3-61. Command sponsored spiritual fitness breakfasts conducted by military chaplains are not prohibited and are authorized when conducted in accordance with the procedures in DA Pam 30-22.
