SUBJECT: Fort George G. Meade (FGGM) Policy Letter # 53, FGGM Family Advocacy Program (FAP)

1. The Family Advocacy Program (FAP) mission is to decrease spouse and child abuse through awareness, education and prevention activities.
2. Incoming unit commanders, senior enlisted advisors and commanding officers should be briefed on the FAP and dynamics of domestic violence within 45 days prior to or following appointment to a command position.
3. All Soldiers should attend annual troop awareness briefings presented by FAP.
4. It is the policy of this command that all personnel will accord alleged domestic violence victims and offenders their rights under the law and applicable regulations.
5. A particular concern is child abuse. The FAP has a New Parent Support Home Visitation Service (NPSHVS) that provides a comprehensive program of education and support to expectant parents and children three years or younger. Both parents, step-parents and intimate partners are encouraged to participate in the NPSHVS.
