A final word ... to garrison employees only! DPMAP is due! And, it's all about you and your career. Here are the significant dates:

31 Mar - All employees rated by the DGC should have completed employee inputs and send to DGC in DPMAP appraisal tool.

30 Apr - Raters should have submitted all proposed ratings in the DPMAP Appraisal Tool for all employees that the DGC is the higher level rater (HLR).

14 May - All garrison employees appraisals should be complete; which means acknowledged by the employee.
