SUBJECT: Command Policy Memorandum #1-Open Door Policy

- 1. Reference: AR 600-20, Army Command Policy.
- 2. I am committed to addressing the concerns of all members of our command. The most effective means for solving problems is open communication using the chain of command. Your supervisory chain often knows more about you and your job and may be in the best position to resolve an issue quickly and satisfactorily. I encourage all personnel to use this highly effective tool to resolve issues at the lowest level possible. If you believe it is necessary to talk directly to me about a complex or sensitive problem which cannot be solved through the chain of command, it is my policy to be available to personally discuss these issues.
- 3. Those wishing to exercise my Open Door Policy should contact the Garrison Headquarters Front Office at (301)-677-4503 to schedule an appointment.
- 4. This policy is not intended to circumvent established administrative processes that are available to resolve employee and service member grievances, complaints, problems, or other similar issues.
- 5. I expect leaders to inform personnel of this policy and to fully support it. No leader in my command will prevent a Soldier or Civilian from speaking to me or any other assistance agency, nor take any form of retribution against them for doing so.
- 6. As a matter of courtesy, I encourage, but do not require, all enlisted service members to first contact my Command Sergeant Major. Similarly, I encourage Civilian employees to first contact my Deputy Garrison Commander. They can each be contacted at (301) 677-4503. These notifications are a courtesy and for possible assistance in resolving the issue. It is not a requirement to see me.
- 7. This policy memorandum supersedes Garrison Policy Memo #1, Open Door Policy, dated 18 Aug 22.
