



- ➤ Ensure your DEERS information is current to receive communications and update from TRICARE
- ➤ Global enrollment freeze on **any** TRICARE health plan enrollment changes **Oct. 25–27.** you won't be able to update your information or make any changes to your plan. This freeze includes overseas and dental enrollments.
- ➤ Between Oct. 28 and Dec. 31, if you need to make health plan changes, you'll need to call your regional contractor (Humana Military, TRICARE East, 1-800-444-5445). You won't be able to make any health plan updates online in milConnect via Beneficiary Web Enrollment.






