FORT GEORGE G. MEADE, Md., - Interested community members are invited to attend the next Fort George G. Meade Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) meeting Thursday, Jan. 17, 2019, at 7:00 p.m. at the Courtyard Marriott, 2700 Hercules Road, Annapolis Junction, MD 20701.

The RAB is a key element of the Fort Meade environmental program which enables the community and representatives of government agencies to meet and exchange information about Fort Meade's environmental cleanup and restoration program and to provide opportunities for public involvement.

Fort Meade is soliciting new RAB members from the community who may be interested in enhancing and improving the installation's environmental program. RAB members are expected to provide advice on environmental restoration issues; attend regular meetings; review and comment on environmental restoration documents; assist in identifying project requirements; and, recommend priorities among sites or projects. In short, RAB members play a vital role in the environmental remediation efforts on Fort Meade
