# **Army Secretary Esper to visit Fort Meade**

**EVENT:** Visit and media availability with Sec. Army Mark Esper **WHEN:** July 6, 2018 – Media show time – 10:15 a.m. – Media avail 11 a.m. **WHERE:** Pershing Conference Room, Fort Meade

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:** Secretary of the Army will visit the nation's front line fort in cyber operations.

Army Secretary Mark T. Esper along with his wife, Leah, will visit a number of organizations during their visit to Fort Meade.

Secretary Esper's first stop will be the Military Entrance Processing Station, Baltimore, which processes individuals for enlistment for every branch of service.

The next stop is 1<sup>st</sup> Recruiting Brigade responsible for recruiting the best talent for the Army, including service members to work in the high tech intelligence and cyber security positions at Fort Meade. Secretary Esper will hold a roundtable with recruiters in the brigade.

While the secretary visits these locations, Leah Esper will tour Kimbrough Ambulatory Care Center, the Medical Department Activity on Fort Meade which provides care in a wide range of clinics for active duty, dependent and retiree care.

After the visits, Secretary Esper will hold a fifteen minute press availability.
