Illuminate the Darkness Walk

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: The second annual Illuminate the Darkness Walk, sponsored by Fort Meade's Cryptologic Warfare Group 6 Suicide Prevention Program, symbolizes shining a light on the darkness that is suicide on the occasion of Suicide Prevention Month.

Fort Meade's Army Substance Abuse Program will also participate in the event, as a way to raise awareness on the connection between alcohol and drug abuse to suicide.

Participants will walk around the track throughout the night with the walk ending at 6:35 a.m. Saturday morning.

Participants will have the opportunity to decorate luminarias, which will line the track, with the names of loved ones or to honor suicide survivors.

The event will begin with an opening ceremony at 6 p.m., which will include several guest speakers.

The walk will begin after the opening ceremony and will feature a DJ, food trucks and a cookout.
