Traffic Delays

FORT GEORGE G. MEADE, Md., - A change to the traffic patterns at multiple Access Control Points on Fort Meade has caused unexpected delays. The changes, implemented Wed. evening, have caused traffic to back up along HWY 175, here today. The delays do not impact the ability to enter the installation for those authorized to do so, however garrison officials suggest budgeting more travel time.
