## Due Outs

- \* Discussed name change for RCI (Residential Communities Initiatives) – Fort Meade's RCI has been renamed the Installation Housing Office which more broadly aligns with the office's functions.
- \* A continuation from the March Community Council, DFMWR provided that those customers opting to use the new nitrogen fill for their automobile tires would receive refills at no cost during the first year as the nitrogen filled tires are not supposed to lose tire pressure due to normal usage.
- \* Corvias announced they were suspending fees associated with residents use of space at the community centers
  - \* There was discussion regarding if and when 175 going toward the 295 Interchange would go back to two lanes. Discussion determined it should happen in the near future for most of 175 as the portion of 175 between Disney and Reece is completed.
- \* Fort Meade Housing initiatives were briefly discussed, focusing on the work of the Residents Focus Groups and some of the changes put in place as a collaboration between residents, Corvias and the Fort Meade Garrison. Ongoing.

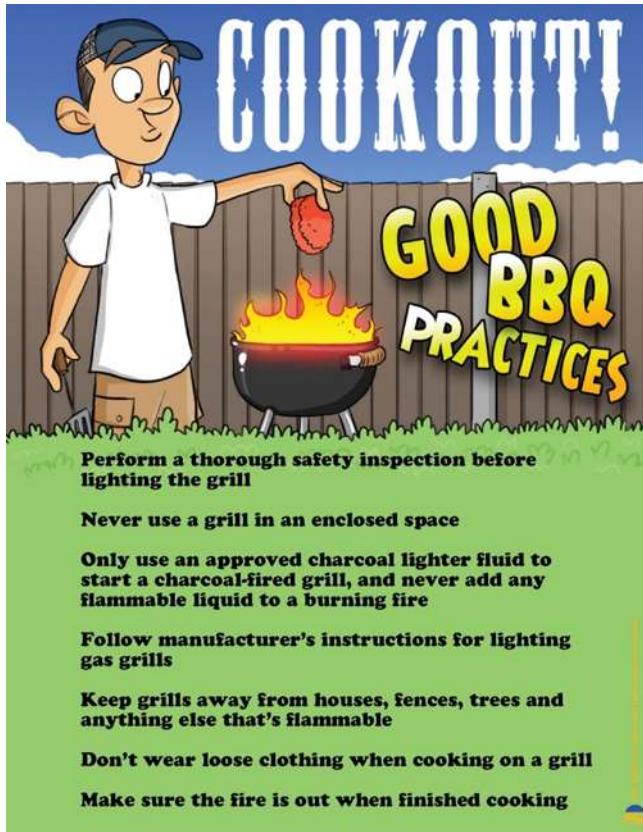

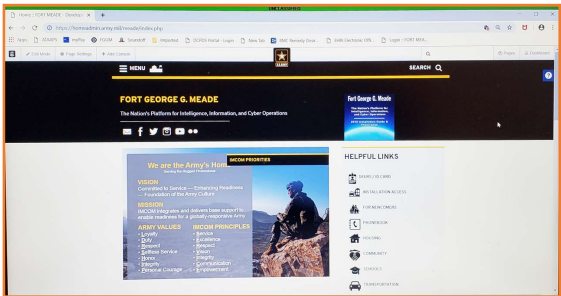
