U.S. ARMY ANNOUNCES SIGNING OF RECORD OF DECISION FOR FORMER TRAP AND SKEET RANGE AT FORT GEORGE G. MEADE, MARYLAND

The U.S. Army at Fort George G. Meade and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency signed a Record of Decision (ROD) for Operable Unit 1, the Former Trap and Skeet Range Site, on December 2, 2025, and January 12, 2026, respectively. The ROD documents the final remedial action chosen for a site.

The ROD selected soil and sediment removal, RCRA Subtitle D disposal, and land use controls as the remedial alternative. All aspects of the remedy are subject to five-year reviews.
