II. Key Updates:

Kimbrough Ambulatory Care Center

- A. Dr. Denise Richardson, Chief Medical Operations:
 - 1. Closures: 18 December closing at 1400, 25 December & 1 January 2025
 - 2. Inclement Weather Notifications: updating operating status with Garrison via Facebook and other social media outlets
 - 3. Pharmacy: to activate new prescriptions, **text:** 833-224-5456, please allow 2 to 4 hours for processing. Busiest times are 1100-1630 & Friday afternoons (especially during Holidays)
 - 4. Primary Care: Video Virtual Appointments available; it will require access to the patient portal; new platform entitled, "Converge" for easier access. Every facility in the NCR will engage in this new process. Literature requested by PAO to market across the group. Group requested assistance with DS Logon to establish accounts. It was mentioned that DINFOS could offer video assistance to help with marketing.
 - 5. Flu and Covid Shots are available via Allergy & Immunizations clinic.
 - 6. MHS Genesis Password Concerns: COL Harris stated assistance needed to decrease frequency of password changes.
