MEMORANDUM FOR U.S. Army Garrison Presidio of Monterey (USAG PoM)

SUBJECT: Command Policy #43, Installation Quiet Hours

1. Purpose: This policy establishes restrictions to the volume of unit training and operational activities conducted on the Presidio of Monterey (PoM) installation.
2. Applicability: This policy applies to all military units conducting collective training or operations within the installation boundaries of PoM main garrison.
3. General: The primary mission conducted on the PoM is the training of military linguists across all military branches. This training regularly extends beyond the classroom and into other service specific facets of the holistic training effort. Service specific requirements, especially those associated with physical fitness and readiness training, at times, incorporate cadence calling, call and response, or other loud shouting or yelling. These activities can be disruptive to routines of dependent Family members living in PoM's housing areas or civilian neighbors living adjacent to our installation boundaries. This policy aims to strike a balance between unit leaders' mandate to train their Servicemembers and adhering to the Army Value of "Respect" for our tenant Families and civilian neighbors of the installation.
4. Policy:
 - a. No unit shall conduct organized physical training or other readiness activities in the military Family housing area on the PoM between the hours of 1700-0700. This area is bounded by Lawton Road to the west, Corporal Evans Road to the south, Stillwell Avenue to the east, and Private Bolio Road to the north. This area includes the roads, sidewalks, fields, and parking lots bounded therein. Cadence calling, group recitation, call and response, loud music, or other shouting or yelling associated with unit training activities is strictly prohibited in this area during these times.
 - b. Units will avoid conducting similar loud training, formations, or readiness activities in any location along the installation's fence line that is immediately adjacent to an off-post residence. This restriction applies at all times. If training must be conducted in the vicinity of off-post residential areas, unit leaders will ensure there is at least one building on the installation between the training location and the neighboring property to

create a physical barrier to reduce the volume reaching those residences and to minimize disruptions to the lives of our neighbors.

5. Exceptions: Units wishing to conduct organized physical training on Soldier Field or at Lower Presidio Historic Park may transit the military Family housing area in formation during quiet hours via Kit Carson Road or Corporal Evans Road but are prohibited from conducting any cadence calling or creating other loud noise that would disturb the residents. All other exceptions must be requested in writing to the Garrison Commander for approval, further delegable only to the Garrison Command Sergeant Major.
