SUBJECT: Command Policy # 21, Photography, Videography and Unmanned Aircraft System (UAS) Activities while on Presidio of Monterey (POM), Ord Military Community (OMC), SHARPE Army Depot and USASA-Camp Roberts

2. Purpose: To establish POM policy and procedures for photography, videography and UAS activities on POM with recording devices (includes but not limited to cameras, cellular phone cameras or GoPro). Commanders have the authority and responsibility to enforce appropriate security measures to protect DOD property and personnel assigned, attached or subject to their Command. Apply good judgement and common sense when balancing POM's security needs with the freedoms of those living, serving and enjoying recreational or command events.

3. Applicability: This policy applies to all persons entering, traveling through, assigned to, in temporary duty status at or employed on POM and their dependents/guests.

SUBJECT: Command Policy # 21, Photography, Videography and Unmanned Aircraft System (UAS) Activities while on Presidio of Monterey (POM), Ord Military Community (OMC), SHARPE Army Depot and USASA-Camp Roberts

Violators may be subject to adverse administrative action and punishment under the UCMJ, be barred from further entry onto the installation (including DOD facilities on OMC), and also be subject to prosecution under state, federal or military law.

4. Proponent: POM's proponent is the Installation Antiterrorism Officer (ATO), (831) 242-7590 or Emergency Manager (EM), (831) 242-7072. Direct requests for CA ANG, Camp Roberts to their Security POC at (805) 238-8542.

5. Authorization for photographing or videography (not UAS) is explicitly granted to the following agencies:

a. Directorate of Emergency Services (DES), Directorate of Public Works (DPW), DPTMS (including Visual Information personnel), Installation Safety Office (ISO) and Public Affairs Office (PAO) are permitted to take photographs, make videos or collect other forms of imagery for official use only.

b. PAO must escort authorized external media personnel at all times and ensure they comply with para 6. Media event organizers must provide an approved escort list to POM PD and DES Dispatch.

c. DOD personnel and housing residents on POM are permitted to take pictures and videos in/around the immediate area around assigned quarters, Command-approved special or ceremonial events, unit functions, DFMWR sporting events, family gatherings and at landmark areas (i.e. Sloat Monument and Berlin Wall Memorial). Compliance with para 6 is required.

d. Participants attending Defense Language Institute, Foreign Language Center (DLIFLC) graduation ceremonies are permitted to take celebratory photographs and/or videos but only in the immediate vicinity and not at locations specified in para 6.

6. The following are not permitted on POM without prior authorization of the Garrison Commander (GC) or designated representative. Send authorization requests (at least two weeks in advance) and/or RFIs through the Installation ATO or EM listed in para 4.

a. Use of UAS on POM is specifically unauthorized due to Federal Aviation Agency flight restrictions within 5 nm of the Monterey Regional Airport (www.faa.gov/uas). Use of non-Dajiang Innovation (DJI) UAS on OMC may be authorized for official purposes by submitting a request (para 7) along with FAA approval and the UAV pilot's FAA-license.

b. No commercial or personal photography, videotaping or global positioning surveys using recording devices (such as, but not limited to, cameras, cellular phone cameras or GoPro) that may be construed as surveillance or intelligence gathering

on/around any installation Access/Entry Control points (including vehicle search areas), DoD mission essential and critical facilities or designated Restricted Areas.

c. No photographing, videotaping or UAS of exterior perimeters of DFMWR Child Development Center (CDC) or Child Youth School Services (CYSS).

d. Non-residents should not be taking photographs within housing areas without prior permission.

7. Requests by agencies not specifically listed in para 5 will be signed by the requesting agency's Director/Commander and routed to DPTMS via the Installation ATO or EM for approval at least two weeks in advance.

8. Report non-compliance with this policy to DES Dispatch, (831) 242-7851. Being alert and reporting suspicious activity protects our DOD communities and property.

9. Violators may be subject to immediate questioning as well as confiscation of any notes, photographs, digital imagery, sketches, maps, cameras, photography equipment or other material describing the installation. They may also be subject to adverse administrative action and punishment under the UCMJ, barred from further entry onto the installation (including DOD facilities on OMC), and subject to prosecution under state, federal or military law.
