SUBJECT: Command Policy #31, Presidio of Monterey (POM) Appropriate Fund Warrior Restaurant (WR) Rules and Dress Code

1. References:

- a. Army Regulation (AR) 30-22, The Army Food Program.
- b. DA PAM 30-22, Operating Procedures for the Army Food Program.
- c. TB MED 530, Tri-Service Food Code.

2. Purpose: To prescribe the conditions under which authorized personnel are permitted to dine in the POM Appropriated Fund WRs.

3. Applicability: This policy applies to all personnel who are given approval to dine in POM's Appropriated Fund WRs.

4. Proponent: The proponent for this policy is the Logistics Readiness Center (LRC) POM Food Program Management Office (FPMO) at 831-242-6160 or 831-242-6542.

5. The following rules apply to all patrons of the WRs:

a. Food or drink served in the dining facilities will not be taken out of the WRs. Exceptions are to-go containers at Chay Hall and Belas Hall WRs, and Cary Grab-n-Go for Service Members during the breakfast, lunch and dinner meals, one piece of fresh fruit or packaged snack per customer, and coffee in a customer provided travel mug.

b. Condiments, dinnerware, glassware, and silverware will not be removed from the WRs.

c. Broken containers, dinnerware or food spillage will be brought to the attention of the WR Managers.

d. Line jumping or saving places in the serving line are not authorized.

e. Public displays of affection (kissing, holding hands, hugging) are not authorized.

6. The following items and activities are prohibited:

- a. Large purses, book bags, backpacks, etc.
- b. The use of smart phones, MP3 players or any other sound producing devices while in the serving lines is prohibited.
- c. Socializing or crowding around the cashier stations and exit routes.
- d. Torn, ragged, or dirty clothing.
- e. Sleeping attire, bathrobes, and bedroom slippers.
- f. Vests, tank tops, halter tops, shirts or blouses which expose the midriff or do not cover the armpits or are made of see-through material.
- g. Obscene patches or patches that are placed obscenely.
- h. Short shorts or cut-offs of any kind.
- i. Hair curlers.
- j. Head coverings will not be worn indoors, unless under arms in an official capacity, or when directed by the Commander, such as for indoor ceremonial activities.

7. Failure to comply with established codes may be cause for denied entry or removal from the facility.

8. Wet, sweat stained, or dirty Military Physical Fitness Training (PT) uniforms from any branch of service are not authorized to dine in the WRs. Carry-out is available at both Chay Hall and Belas Hall WRs, and at the Chay Grab-n-Go for the breakfast, lunch and dinner meal periods, and from the Kiosk, when open.

9. Abusive language, loud talking, or yelling are not authorized.

10. Televisions will be set on BBC or ESPN channels and operated only by the WR staff.
