MEMORANDUM FOR DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Order Incorporating County of Monterey COVID-19 Restrictions for All Individuals Subject to Department of Defense (DoD) Authority on U.S. Army Garrison, Presidio of Monterey

1. In an effort to reduce the spread of novel coronavirus (COVID-19), the County of Monterey has issued orders directing all individuals living within the County to shelter at their place of residence, and to wear face coverings when entering public places while conducting essential activities. The Presidio of Monterey incorporates and applies all County of Monterey COVID-19 Orders to all individuals subject to DoD authority on U.S. Army Garrison, Presidio of Monterey. For purposes of this Order, the Presidio of Monterey includes the Defense Language Institute Foreign Language Center; the Ord Military Community; La Mesa Village; and U.S. Army Signal Activity-Camp Roberts.

2. This Order incorporates directives published in Presidio of Monterey Face Covering Order, dated 28 April 2020; Defense Language Institute Foreign Language Center Pandemic Order #1, dated 01 April 2020; and Presidio of Monterey Order Relating to COVID-19, dated 20 March 20.

3. Effective 30 April 2020, all military personnel, family members, guests, DoD civilian employees, DoD contractors, lease tenants, and other individuals on Presidio of Monterey shall comply with County of Monterey COVID-19 restrictions, subject to the following conditions:

a. Prohibited Activities.

(1) Use of playgrounds, picnic areas, tennis courts, basketball courts, dog parks or common barbeque areas on Presidio of Monterey;

(2) Use of Presidio Park and Museum on Lower Presidio (walking or running through this area is authorized);

(3) Use of La Mesa Sports Field and Hayes Park Soccer Field in groups of any number of people not comprised of a single household;

(4) Engaging in team sports activities of any kind on the above listed fields; and

(5) Gatherings of any number of people from outside a single household or residence. This includes parties or gatherings in a residence or common area where individuals from outside of that residence are present, excepted as authorized under paragraph 3.b(3) below. For purposes of this Order, barracks are not considered a single household or residence.

b. Permitted Activities.

SUBJECT: Order Incorporating County of Monterey COVID-19 Restrictions for All Individuals Subject to Department of Defense (DoD) Authority on U.S. Army Garrison, Presidio of Monterey

(1) Members of a single household gathering within their private residence or within their immediate domicile.

(2) Members of a single household sitting, playing, barbequing or gathering on their lawn or porch.

(3) Gatherings of no more than six (6) individuals in a residence yard as long as Social Distancing Requirements are maintained (6 feet). If Social Distancing Requirements cannot be maintained, a face covering is required to be worn by all individuals in the gathering.

(4) Outdoor recreation activities including walking, hiking, bicycling, running and exercising as long as there is no gathering of any number of people outside of a single household. No more than six (6) Service Members from the same barracks can engage in these activities together. When engaging in the above listed activities, Social Distancing Requirements must be observed. During such activities, a face covering is not required to be worn, but individuals must carry a face covering with them.

(5) Members of a single household or family playing, walking, or running on Price Fitness Center Field and Track, Soldier's Field and Hilltop Field.


(6) Sports activities that include the use of shared equipment may only be engaged in by members of the same household.

(7) Service Member use of Price Fitness Center Field and Track, Soldier's Field and Hilltop Field, individually or in groups of no more than six (6) from the same barracks as long as Social Distancing Requirements are strictly maintained. A face covering is not required to be worn, but individuals must carry a face covering with them. If Social Distancing Requirements cannot be maintained, a face covering must be worn.

4. This order will remain in effect until rescinded. Exceptions to this requirement may be requested through local commanders or supervisors to me for decision.

5. Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this Order constitutes an imminent threat to the national defense missions served at the Presidio of Monterey. Service Members violating or failing to obey this order are subject to appropriate administrative, non-judicial, and/or judicial action under the Uniform Code of Military Justice. Department of Defense civilians and/or other individuals subject to DoD authority on Presidio of Monterey who violate or fail to obey this order are subject to appropriate administrative and judicial action under state and federal law.
