MEMORANDUM FOR Presidio of Monterey Installation

SUBJECT: United States Army Garrison (USAG) Presidio of Monterey (PoM),
Command Policy #7 – Off-Limits Establishments

1. **Reference.** Army Regulation 190-24, OPNAVINST 1620.2A, AFI 31-213, MCO 1620.2D, COMDTINST 1620.1E, Subject: Armed Forces Disciplinary Control Boards and Off Installation Liaison and Operations

2. **Proponent.** The proponent for this policy is the Directorate of Emergency Services.

3. **Purpose.** To establish a command policy prohibiting the patronage of off-limits establishments, in accordance with guidance from the Armed Forces Disciplinary Control Board (AFDCB).

4. **Applicability.** This policy supersedes all previous policies on the subject and applies to all Service Members assigned to the United States Army Garrison Presidio of Monterey and the Defense Language Institute Foreign Language Center (DLIFLC).

5. Off-limits Establishments and Areas.

a. In accordance with the applicable joint regulation cited above, any conditions which would adversely affect the health, safety, welfare, morale, and discipline of the Armed Forces may be declared off limits by the AFDCB. The AFDCB may take appropriate action on conditions in their area of responsibility in relation to any establishment or business deemed unsafe, adversely impacts good order and discipline, or which may adversely affect the health and well-being of military personnel or their families. Use of such establishments or businesses may not be considered in the line of duty and may require the Service Member to pay associated medical costs.

b. Establishments. Name changes to the following establishments will not remove them from the off-limits list and must go through the AFDCB for the removal process. The following establishments are off limits effective the date of this memorandum:

1) Mary Jane'z Novelties, 744 Lighthouse Drive, Monterey, CA 93940

2) Norcal Smoke Shop, 765 Lighthouse Drive, Monterey, Ca 93940

- 3) Twisted Roots, 482 Alvarado Street, Monterey, CA 93940
- 4) Twisted Roots, 265 Reservation Road, Marina, CA 93933
- 5) My Care Giver, 554 Lighthouse Avenue, Monterey, CA 93940
- 6) Santa Cruz Patient Collective, 115 Limekiln Street, Santa Cruz, CA 95060
- 7) MediLeaf Collective, 1321-B First Street, Gilroy, CA 95020
- 8) WAMM: WoMen's Alliance for Medical Marijuana. 309 Cedar St. #39, Santa Cruz, CA 95060
- 9) Indian Summer, 220 Olivier Street, Monterey, CA 93940
- 10) All unlicensed tattoo parlors
- 11) All unlisted and future marijuana distribution locations

c. Off-limits establishments are prohibited from advertising on the installation.

6. **Enforceability.** This policy is punitive. Military personnel entering off-limits establishments are in violation of a lawful order and are subject to disciplinary action under Article 92 of the Uniform Code of Military Justice. All alleged violations of this policy will be referred to the appropriate military commander, supervisor, Dean, or Associate Provost for disposition after consultation with the appropriate service commander's legal advisor.
