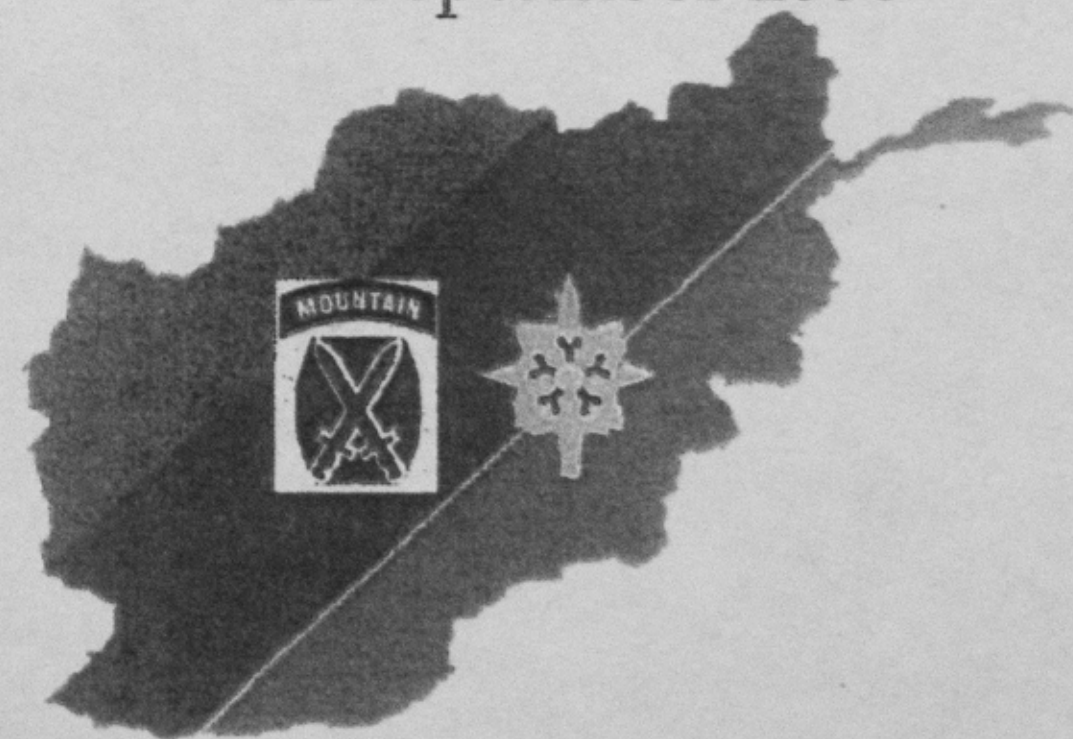
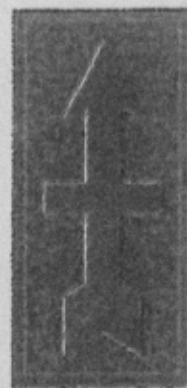

Corporal Bernard Paul Corpuz joined the United States Army on 15 July 2004 and completed Basic Training at Fort Jackson, South Carolina. He went on to DLI in Monterey, California where he learned French. Upon completion of DLI, Corporal Corpuz completed the 97E-Interrogator course at Fort Huachuca, Arizona.

Corporal Corpuz was assigned to Bravo Company, 321st Military Intelligence Battalion on 19 October 2005. Upon mobilization in support of Operation Enduring Freedom, he deployed and served as an interrogator for the 232nd Military Intelligence Company at the Joint Interrogation Facility at Bagram Airfield as well as at the Field Detention Site in Ghazni.

Corporal Corpuz's awards include: the Bronze Star Medal (P), the Purple Heart (P), the Army Good Conduct Medal (P), National Defense Service Medal, the Afghanistan Campaign Medal (P), Global War on Terror Service Medal and the Army Service Ribbon. Corporal Corpuz was also awarded the Combat Action Badge (P).

Corporal Bernard Paul Corpuz is survived by his parents Margaret and Bernaldo Corpuz, sister Salette Corpuz and loving girlfriend Katie.
