*If an additional recycling container is needed, it can be requested through NSSC Environmental Office*

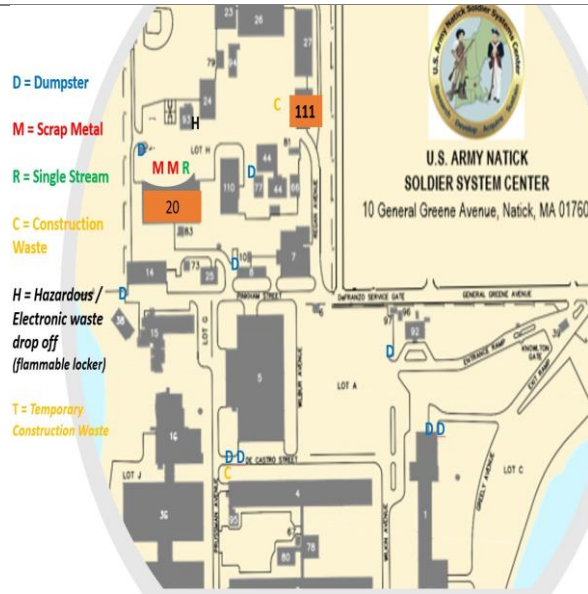

## Trash Pick-Up Every Thursday / Recycling Every Other Thursday

### How Do I Get Rid Of My Waste?

**Solid Waste:** Anything collected in resident trash bins.  
Ex: food waste, napkins, soiled / food contaminated materials, Styrofoam, non-recyclable packaging, etc.

Bag in trash bags and place in provided blue trash bin for curbside pickup on Thursdays

**Recycling Waste:** Paper, cardboard, glass, aluminum, plastics, cereal boxes, books, magazines, etc, anything with a "recycling number" printed on it.

Place loose single stream mixed recyclables in provided blue bins for curbside pickup every other Thursday

\*Additional bins can be requested if needed

**Green Waste:** Yard clippings, leaves, brush, broken branches, etc

**Construction & Remodeling Waste:** Non recyclable home items like Drywall, carpet, plumbing, furniture, building materials, etc.

- Excludes mattresses and tires

To be transported and placed in C&D Dumpster on base located next to building 111

**Scrap Metal:** Large items such as filing cabinets, aluminum siding, faucets fixtures, lawn chairs, locks & door knobs, pipe, etc.

To be transported and placed in scrap metal dumpster on base behind building 20

**Electronic Waste:** TVs, computers, printers, cable cords, power cords, stereos, etc.

1. Notify DPW-Env via call or text  
2. Materials are to be transported to base and placed in the yellow flammable cabinet outside of Building 93

**Hazardous Materials:** Aerosol cans (even if empty), paints, oil, batteries, lightbulbs, cleaning products, insect repellent, drain cleaners, etc.

All items must be non-leaking.  
1. Notify DPW-Env via call or text  
2. Materials are to be transported to base and placed in the yellow flammable cabinet outside of Building 93
