Colonel Sean Keefe, hailing from Buffalo, New York, currently serves as the Director of Training and Doctrine at the United States Army Aviation Center of Excellence at Fort Novosel, Alabama.

He earned his U.S. Army commission in May 2001 upon graduating from Canisius College in New York, with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Psychology. He holds a Master of Arts degree in Managerial Economics from the University of Oklahoma, a Master of Military Studies degree from the U.S. Marine Corps University, and a Master of Strategic Studies degree from the U.S. Army War College.

Colonel Keefe began his military career as a Chemical Officer in 3-13th Multiple Launch Rocket System (MLRS) Battalion at Fort Sill, Oklahoma. In May 2004, he transferred to the Aviation Branch, qualifying in the OH-58D(R) Kiowa Warrior and later the UH-60M Blackhawk helicopters. After more than 24 years of service, he has held various leadership and staff assignments, and deployed in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom twice and in support of Operation Atlantic Resolve.

Colonel Keefe's leadership assignments include Maintenance Platoon Leader, Flight Platoon Leader, and Troop Commander in 6-6th Cavalry Squadron, Fort Drum, New York; Alpha Company Commander, 1-145th Aviation Battalion, Fort Novosel, Alabama; and Battalion Commander, 96th Aviation Support Battalion, Fort Campbell, Kentucky.

His staff assignments include Assistant Operation Officer, 6-6th Cavalry Squadron, Fort Drum, New York; Battalion Operations and Brigade Operations Officer in 3rd Combat Aviation Brigade, Hunter Army Airfield, Georgia; Defense Trade Analyst and Deputy Division Chief, Directorate of Defense Trade of Controls, U.S. Department of State; Chief of the Congressional Affairs Officer, Headquarters Department of the Army (HQDA), Deputy Chief of Staff (DCS) G-3/5/7, Pentagon; Aviation Enablers Branch Chief, HQDA G-8, Department of Army Personnel and Readiness - Force Development Division (DAPR-FDV), Pentagon.

Colonel Keefe's awards and decorations include the Bronze Star Medal, Defense Meritorious Service Medal, Meritorious Service Medals (four Oak Leaf Clusters), Air Medal, Army Commendation Medals (five OLC), Army Achievement Medals (four OLC), National Defense Service Medal, Iraqi Campaign Medals (four Bronze Campaign Stars), Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, Combat Action Badge, Senior Army Aviator Badge, Air Assault Bade, and the Parachutist Badge.

He is married to the former Melissa Manaresi of Buffalo, New York, and is a proud father to two children: Tyler and Leah.
