When deemed appropriate hiring managers non-competitively promote veterans in their organizations.
There are 3 hiring authorities used to recruit veterans, VEOA, VRA, and 30%.
VEOA is required for all position announcements that are permanent.
VRA and 30% are used to recruit veterans non-competitively and hiring managers will hire qualified veterans directly into the position without a announcement.
The 30% hiring authority is also used on all positions (term, temp, and perm) to seek out disabled veterans when requested by the hiring manager or when deemed appropriate by the staffer and approved by the hiring manager.
Training selecting officials, interviewers, and Subject Matter Experts (SMEs) on ensuring consistency in the niring process, including requirements of the American's with Disabilities Act of 1990, the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, and Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
Fort Novosel will conduct Job Fairs throughout the year to recruit and retain veterans, especially those that are 30% or more disabled.

16. A description of how the agency will provide or improve internal advancement opportunities for disabled veterans (Attach supporting addendums if needed)
I.S. Army Fort Novosel continues to challenge the civilian workforce, including disabled veterans, to actively eek educational opportunities through self-development and formal education and by taking advantage of the civilian Education System (CES). In fact the CES Intermediate and Advanced courses will be held on Fort
lovosel FY25 to promote this effort. This training provides enhanced leader development and educational

Disability program awareness is provided to all employees, particularly during the observance of National Disability Employment Awareness Month each October. Fort Novosel conducted a National Disability Employment Awareness Month Fair for all members of the workforce, including disabled veterans on 20 October 2023. Members of the Disabled American Veterans (DAV) was in attendance as well as several displays to promote internal advancement opportunities for the organization's veteran population.

opportunities for civilians, to include disabled veterans.

The EEO office took part in the Army Heritage Month Event on 13 June 2024, promoting Disability Employment Awareness with educational materials, Reasonable Accommodation information hand-outs, on-line Computer Display to instruct how to access the Computer/Electronic Accommodations Program (CAP) database.

Information was given to supervisors during the annual EEO No Fear training focusing on the importance of the RA interactive processes to maintain our employee's with disabilities and to ensure Disabled Veterans in the workforce are familiar and understand the procedures. Fort Novosel includes the utilization of a Reasonable Accommodation panel comprised of the EEO Disability Program Manager, Labor Representative, Labor/Management Employee Relations Specialist, Occupational Health Physician, and the employee's supervisor. The panel provides advice and guidance to supervisors and managers during the decision making process to grant or deny a request for an accommodation. Accommodations such as an ergonomic mouse, sit-to-stand desks, ergonomic chairs, telework, and as a last resort reassignment have all been provided to disabled veterans on Fort Novosel. These accommodations have allowed the veteran population to enjoy the full range of continued employment and enhanced the accomplishment of the training mission on Fort Novosel.

When deemed appropriate hiring managers continue to non-competitively promote veterans in their organizations.

11. An explanation of the agency's progress in implementing its affirmative action plan during the fiscal year. USAG Fort Novosel continues to focus on recruiting and retaining disabled veterans. The retention of disabled veterans decreased 99.47% (from 191 to 190) during FY24, and a decrease of 99.36% in the IMCOM Appropriate Fund (FY) workforce population (from 316 to 314). Of the thirty-nine (39) veterans hired, 84.61% (33/39) were veterans with 30 percent or more disability. Fifty-two (52) disabled veterans were hired within MCOM at Fort Novosel utilizing the Veterans Recruitment Appointment (VRA) hiring authority and five (5) Disabled Veterans were appointed under Veterans Employment Opportunities Act (VEOA). The agency is working to re-align over-hires to retain current employees, but to realize an overall population of the authorized 314. Continued consideration should be given during recruitment to bring qualified disabled veterans to the Fort Novosel workforce. USAG Fort Novosel will monitor participation rates and recruitment efforts that influence disabled veterans, as the manpower reductions take place. Disabled veterans, including those with 30 percent or more disability, will continue to be eligible to participate in outreach, mentoring and special hiring apportunities.
The EEO Office conducted a Disability Employment Month Fair in October 2023, with participation by the local Wounded Warriors, Disabled American Veterans Administration, Dothan Career Center, Alabama Department of Rehab and various colleges to bring awareness to the recuitment, promotion and retention of disabled veterans.
The EEO Office also participated in the Army Heritage Month Fair in June 2024, promoting Disability Employment Awareness with information, computer access and a demonstration to the website Computer /Electronic Accommodations Program (CAP) to assist with any Reasonable Accommodations necessary to help our employed Disabled Veterans receive assistive technology and employment support services.
The Fort Novosel Transition Assistance Program conducted six (6) events through FY24 to include "Hiring Our Heroes" on 18 July 2024, attended by 74 Employers, 303 Soldiers, and 16 Retirees.
