E-EFMP

Enterprise - Exceptional Family Member Program System



Enterprise EFMP (E-EFMP)

The new digital platform streamlines enrollment, makes assignment coordination and family support access easier, and synchronizes all aspects of care for families with special needs.

- **Family Member Travel Screening (FMTS)**
 - Required for all Family members accompanying Service members OCONUS, including Hawaii and Alaska.
 - #1 reason for delay is a Family member not completing an annual physical.
- **EFMP Packet Processing - Medical and Education**
 - Enrollment via self-referral, early intervention staff, or medical provider.
 - Updates every 3 years or if there is a significant change to the Family member's diagnosis or treatment plan.
 - Disenrollment due to retirement or separation from the Army, divorce or custody change to non-service member.
- **Compassionate Actions**
 - Reassignment to a location with the resources your Family member requires.
 - Stabilization at your current location for continuity of care.

DIRECTORATE OF PUBLIC SAFETY (DPS)

The Trusted Traveler program allows valid DoD ID card holders to enter Fort Novosel without the requirement for occupants of the same vehicle to present identification. The Trusted Traveler program does not apply to restricted areas, airfields, or heliports.

Effective 1 October 2023

- **Trusted Travelers** are U.S. service members, adult dependents, DoD employees, and military retirees and their spouses – with valid DoD identification.
- **Trusted Travelers** are **not** installation visitor pass holders, volunteers, family care providers, foreign personnel, contractors, tow truck drivers, or taxi, limousine, shuttle, or ride-share drivers conducting duties for commercial purposes (even with valid DoD identification).
- **Trusted Travelers** are limited to a single non-commercial vehicle and may not vouch for personnel in another vehicle.
- **Trusted Travelers** with valid DOD identification will always be verified and may only vouch for occupants in the same vehicle.
- **Trusted Travelers** must remain with personnel they are escorting who are not in possession of a valid DOD ID, or authorized Fort Novosel visitor credential, and they must ensure all vehicle occupants have a valid form of identification in their possession.
- **Trusted Traveler** hours are from 5 a.m. to 10 p.m. (0500-2200), 7 days a week.

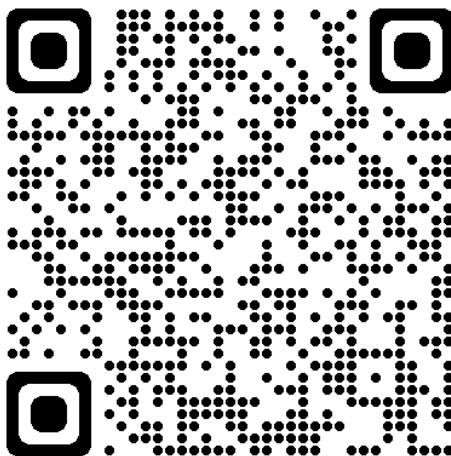
Fort Novosel Map
