Registration: Using your CAC on the Ft. Rucker network (Wi-Fi at Landing & other areas on post) Works best using **Google Chrome** from a **Military Network** at: <https://imc.army.mil/airs/>

IAW AR 385-10: BRC required prior to riding, on or off post. ARC required within 1 year of BRC and every 5 years thereafter. Motorcycle training is limited to **Military** personnel.

Cancellations/Rescheduling: Please CAC back into <https://imc.army.mil/airs/> to cancel your reservation. Annotate the reason for cancellation. Rescheduling requires you to **first cancel your reservation request**, then create a new reservation.

Location: B-6030 Andrews Ave (btwn Yano Hall & Lemon Lot)

Walk-in: Arrive 15 minutes early. First-Come, First-Serve.

Motorcyclists must bring/wear the following:

- DOT Approved Helmet (**available if needed**)
- Long sleeved shirt/jacket and pants
- Sturdy over-the-ankle footwear
** The local MSF instructor has final authority in determining whether footwear and other PPE worn is acceptable during training.
- Valid driver's license
- Full-fingered gloves



Note: ARC – Must have own motorcycle or written permission of owner, insurance, proof of BRC, and Motorcycle Endorsement on DL; **complete ARC within 12-months of BRC.**
