MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: U.S. Army on Okinawa Off-Limits Locations

1. References:

a. AR 190-24, Armed Forces Disciplinary Control Boards and Off-Installation Liaison and Operations, 27 July 2006;

b. III Marine Expeditionary Force/Marine Corps Installations Pacific Bulletin 5800 and 5800.1.

2. Applicability. This policy applies to all SOFA-status personnel assigned, attached, or otherwise present for duty with the U.S. Army on Okinawa and their SOFA-status Family members.

3. Policy. After following the procedures of the referenced joint regulation, the Okinawa Armed Forces Disciplinary Control Board has determined that the activities at these establishments on Okinawa constitute a threat to the health, safety, and welfare of SOFA-status personnel. As the General Court-Martial Convening Authority for the U.S. Army on Okinawa, I am directing that the following 18 establishments, to include the physical location, to be "off-limits," to all U.S. Army-sponsored, SOFA-status personnel:

a. Ground Tobacco Shop: 2F, 1-5-9 Mihama; Chaton-Cho, Okinawa, Japan;

b. Bullseye, 4-16 Kitame, Chatan, Okinawa, Japan;

c. Takahara Hotel (also known as the Royal Hotel; above the ruins in Nakagusuku Castle Park, near Camp Foster);

d. Club Epica, 900-0032 Okinawa, Naha, Matsuyama, 1 Chome-5-1, 3F;

e. Yoshihara Red-Light District (establishments with storefronts that face Highways 329 or 330 are not off limits);

f. Club Harvel, 2 Chrome-13-14 Kumoji, Naha-Shi, Okinawa 900-0015;

g. Tokyo Syoten Bookstore, Highway 23 at 820-6 Kamisedo, Chatan-Cho, Okinawa, Japan

h. OM's Herb Shop; 2F, 3-7-12 Yafuso, Urasoe-Shi, Okinawa, Japan;

i. Yasu Ichi Bookstore; 2-1-10 Chatan-Cho, Okinawa, Japan;

j. Soap Land, Area 2, Tsuji District, Naha-shi is a 3x4 block area within Area 2 consisting of 56 bathhouses. The western boundary is Gas Dori Street and Salada Bowling Alley. Northern boundary is Route 47. Eastern boundary is Route 43, and the southern boundary begins at Gas Dori and 127.668 (longitude and ends at Route 43 and 127.671 longitude).

4. This policy memorandum is punitive in nature and violations will be considered for discipline under Articles 90 and 92 of the Uniform Code of Military Justice for Soldiers. The full range of regulatory and administrative sanctions will be considered for Soldiers, Civilians, Family members, and Contractors.

5. This memorandum supersedes 10th Support Group Command Policy Memorandum 20-16, 21 December 2020, subject as above.
