SUBJECT: Commander's Open Door Policy

- 1. REFERENCE: Army Regulation (AR) 600-20, Army Command Policy, 24 July 2020.
- 2. PURPOSE: To inform personnel of the Garrison Commander's open door policy and to provide guidance for its use.
- 3. APPLICABILITY: This policy applies to all personnel of the U.S. Army Garrison (USAG) Okinawa, and other units or activities attached for the purpose of providing support.
- 4. GENERAL: All commanders, directors, and staffs will ensure that personnel in their units/organizations are briefed and understand the policy.

# 5. POLICY:

- a. It is important to the success of our mission and to our individual well-being that problems, real or perceived, be promptly addressed. Most problems can and should be rapidly resolved through established supervisory channels. Occasionally, however, issues arise that are of such a nature as to cause individuals to feel that they cannot comfortably use the chain of command. For this reason, my door is always open to listen and help resolve issues.
- b. Should circumstances require you to meet with me, contact the Garrison Command Office at 652-4013/4341 to schedule an appointment. No one will suffer any negative repercussions for utilizing the open door policy.
- 6. This command policy supersedes USAG Okinawa Command Policy 600, 13 September 2019, and will remain in effect until rescinded or superseded.
