CERTIFIED COPIES AT TORII STATION

Military notaries may only certify copies of original documents. In accordance with Army Regulation (AR) 27-55, para. 4-5, with very few exceptions (see below), the Legal Assistance Office **cannot** certify documents that are available from an official source such as:

- Court Records
- · Birth Certificates
- Marriage Certificates
- Death Certificates
- Car Titles
- Military Leave and Earning Statements

The Legal Assistance Office may only authenticate copies of public records or publicly recorded documents for <u>military administration</u> (<u>including finance and personnel administration</u>) and for <u>Federal administration</u> where allowed by law or other regulation.

For Social Security Card applications and military administrative purposes, the Legal Assistance Office may make **authenticated** copies of needed documents, but must include the "authenticated for _____" language.

If you want to "certify" your own copies (we will notarize your signature), you should do the following:

Make copies of the documents and present both the originals and the copies to a notary with the language below typed on the front (if room is available) or back of the copies:
