LEGAL ASSISTANCE AT TORII STATION

The Okinawa Law Center on Torii Station offers legal services to all Servicemembers, DoD Civilians, Retired Servicemembers, and Family Members. If you need a power of attorney, notary, or other legal service, please call 652-4332 to set up an appointment. An attorney is available to provide legal advice on a wide range of personal legal assistance issues.

If legal counseling or assistance is desired on a personal legal matter, the Okinawa Law Center is available to help you. Assistance at the Okinawa Law Center includes: ⁱ

- Notaries, Powers of Attorney
- Estate Planning: Wills, Testamentary Trusts, Guardianships, and Advance Medical Directives (Living Wills and Healthcare Powers of Attorney
- Immigration and Naturalization
- Family Law Matters (Marriage, Annulment, Legal Separation, Divorce, Financial Nonsupport, Child Custody and Visitation, Paternity, and assistance with Family Care Plans)
- Military Administrative Matters (Letters of Reprimand, Military Evaluation Appeals, Line of Duty and Financial Liability Investigations)
- Miscellaneous areas: Consumer Transactions and Landlord/Tenant issues

For those with legal concerns, it is important to not delay seeking legal assistance. If a notice to appear in court is received, an attorney should be contacted right away. Most legal problems only get worse when neglected. In most cases, the sooner an attorney is consulted on an issue, the better.

There are some limitations on our legal assistance services. We may not advise clients with employment law cases, claims against the U.S. Government, or military criminal cases. For help in those areas, a private attorney should be consulted, or in military justice cases, a trial defense attorney.

Legal Tip for the Month of January: Please check your Last Will and Testament to see if you want to change anything. If you do not have a Will, please consider making an appointment with the legal assistance office to discuss your estate plan.
