JAPANESE CRIMINAL LAW

All U.S. Forces personnel and family members are subject to Japanese Criminal Laws both on post and off post.

Provided here is a general orientation/ guidance to what a person may expect when involved with the Japanese Criminal Justice system and authorities.

Should you become involved in an incident that may result in Japanese criminal investigations, please contact our office.



- You should **cooperate** with the Japanese authorities and appear for the requested interviews. Escort may be required.
- Recommend to only **sign statements** in English which you wholly agree.
- Japanese police can **DETAIN** a person upon arrest for <u>72 hours</u> without a court order.
- With a court order you can be DETAINED for <u>another 20 days</u> before indictment.
- **BAIL** is set <u>AFTER</u> indictment.
- You will be placed on INTERNATIONAL HOLD when we receive notice of an alleged violation of Japanese Law.
- If you were performing **OFFICIAL DUTIES** at the time of the incident, immediately notify our office.
- Legal Office will assist with retaining a **JAPANESE Attorney** to represent you.
