### **Notice of Availability – Action Memorandum, Camp Parks Site CCPRFTA-06**

The United States Army announces the availability of the Action Memorandum for the Non Time-Critical Removal Action for the site CCPRFTA-06 (Burn Pits), Parks Reserve Forces Training Area, Dublin, CA (Camp Parks). The Action Memorandum documents the Army's decision to protect human health and the environment through excavation and off-site disposal of contaminated soil and associated waste, debris, and ash at the site.

The United States Army is the lead executing agency, responsible for cleanup of the site, and the State (California Department of Toxic Substances Control and California Regional Water Quality Control Board) are support agencies. The selected alternative is considered the best approach to protect the public and the environment and comply with regulatory requirements.
